You will also receive an Ash Wednesday Kit to take with you containing: a small wooden cross, an individual communion cup, a piece of burlap with an ash cross, and a card with information about the evening service. For those unable to attend either drive through but wanting to participate, contact the church office and request the delivery of a kit. One will be delivered to you prior to Wednesday's service.

The Safe Reopening Task force reviewed the data regarding new cases in Sedgwick County and available hospital beds on Tuesday, January 26. The 14 day rolling average of new COVID cases in our county has decreased during the previous two week period. However, the Sedgwick County COVID dashboard continues to classify our hospital status as critical and indicates there are not any available ICU beds. Per the Task Force's review, we will continue in Phase 1 of our plan for reopening the building. The next assessment is on 2/9/2021.

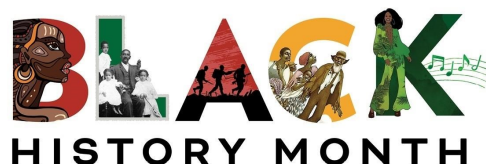
