Phase 4 Continues - On Tuesday, 4/27/2021, the Safe Reopening Task force reviewed the data regarding new cases in Sedgwick County and available hospital beds. The 14 day rolling average of new COVID cases in our county has increased slightly during the previous two week period. The Sedgwick County COVID dashboard classifies our hospital status as "green/good" and indicates there are available ICU beds. We will continue in Phase 4. The next assessment is on 5/11/2021.
