CHUM's Safe Reopening Task Force - On Wednesday, 9/9/2020, the Safe Reopening Task force reviewed the data regarding new cases in Sedgwick County and available hospital beds. The 14 day rolling average of new COVID cases in our county has decreased steadily during the previous 2 week period. In addition, though the Sedgwick County COVID dashboard classifies our hospital status as moderate, it indicates there are more beds available than in previous review periods. Per the Task Force's review, we will advance to Phase 2 of our plan for reopening the building. The next assessment is on 9/15/2020.
