CHUM's Safe Reopening Task Force - On Tuesday, 9/22/2020, the Safe Reopening Task force reviewed the data regarding new cases in Sedgwick County and available hospital beds. The 14 day rolling average of new COVID cases in our county has been relatively stable during the previous two week period, but doesn't show a steady decline. In addition, though the Sedgwick County COVID dashboard classifies our hospital status as moderate, it indicates there are more beds available than there were two weeks ago. Per the Task Force's review, we will continue in Phase 2 of our plan for reopening the building. The next assessment is on 10/13/2020.

TAX NEWS FOR 2020: The CARES Act makes a **new charitable deduction** available to individual taxpayers that do not itemize their deductions. This new benefit, also referred to as a universal deduction, allows for a charitable deduction of up to \$300 per individual. This is an above-the-line contribution that is deducted from the individual taxpayer's income prior to the calculation of their adjusted gross income. This is the one charitable giving benefit that will extend beyond the 2020 tax year.
