We are partnering with Eva Church of Christ to collect items to send to the Ukraine. The orphanages supported are scattered throughout the western part of Ukraine, away from the front lines of fighting. Still, their cities are subject to occasional rocket or drone attack. Orphans are separated by gender and special needs such as sight impaired, deaf, tuberculosis and general

disabilities/Downs. These efforts support 2,500-3,000 orphans along with refugee mothers and children. All aid is distributed by local congregations and members of the church. A trailer (U-Haul) will be available in the parking lot on Saturday, September 28, and Sunday, September 29, for you to bring your items. Please put your items in 13 gallon trash bags (as appropriate) and pack into the trailer yourself. Below is a list of needed items.

Urgent needs for baby/toddler care items:

Small size Vaseline or generic

Wash clothes

Wet wipes

Disposable diapers

Baby blankets

Hats, toboggans, scarves, gloves

Shoes, socks

Baby oil, lotion, wash, shampoo (liquids should be in smaller size bottles)

Needs for children age 3 to 17:

Clothes, coats, underwear(new only)

Shoes, socks

Belts, caps

(Any need your child has, they have.)

Small dolls or single plastic toys that will fit in a 5-gallon bucket

Benevolent needs of refugees:

Clothes, coats (men & women)

Blankets, wash clothes, towels, shampoo

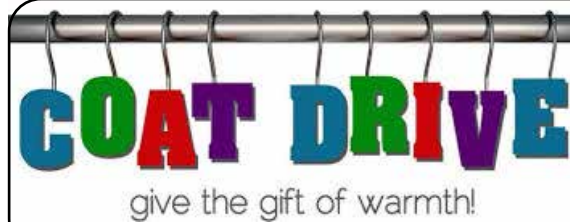
Caps, toboggans, gloves, belts

Crutches (all ages), walkers, wheelchairs

Canes, walking sticks, sticks for the blind

Suitcases, sturdy tote bags, back packs

This effort is to give aid from our abundance. **Do not take from your regular giving.** However, if you have no items to give and want to buy items, that will be helpful.
