Although the study is a few years old now and the percentages might have changed a bit in each category over the years, I doubt the percentages have changed very much, especially as it relates to "Friends & Relatives."

Walk-Ins (show up at a church looking for God)	2-3%
Church Programs	2-3%
Preacher	5-6%
Special Need Met by the Church	1-2%
VisitationProgram	2-2%
Sunday School	4-5%
Gospel Meetings, Revivals, Campaigns, Workshops, Special Events	1-2%
Friends & Relatives	75-90%

While all the above categories and percentages contribute to the overall process of friendship evangelism, if these numbers remain even close to being accurate, then it's obvious where most of our evangelistic energy should be expended, and where most of our evangelistic success will come from.
