10 COMMON BARRIERS TO CHURCH GROWTH

- #1 THE BARRIER OF INSTITUTIONALISM: Red-tape bureaucracy. Big government. "Going to church" verses being the church. Focus of the church is mainly inward instead of outward.
- #2 EXTREMISM: Both legalism and liberalism.
 - Legalism: Binding where God has not bound. Opinions and individual preferences of most "influential members" often dictate "where we stand."
 - Liberalism: Loosing where God has bound. More concerned with making people feel good than God's truth. Produces spiritual relativism.
- #3 UNFOCUSED VISION: The church either lacks vision or isn't focused on what's most important.
- #4 PEOPLE-BLINDNESS: Programs are emphasized more than people. The church is nice and considerate to each other, but not much focus on the needs of visitors and outsiders.
- #5 CLERICALISM: The church expects most of the ministry to be done by people with titles, especially ones the church pays a salary. Not only is this unscriptural, but the church can't hire enough people to get it all done. The church is primarily a "volunteer army."
- #6 HIGH-TECH INSTEAD OF HIGH TOUCH: These churches are filled with technology, but void of tears for the lost and hurting. The church must stay "high-touch" in a "high-tech" world. However, the church should also stay up to date with technology and use it effectively to serve people.
- #7 EDIFICE COMPLEX: Too much focus on the church building and what is done there, instead of going into the world.
- #8 IMAGE IN THE COMMUNITY: The church either has a negative image in the community for some reason, or it has no defined image. The community only sees it as a building, because the church is making little to no impact on the community.
- #9 TRADITIONALISM: The church is bound to traditional ways of doing things. Famous last words of these churches - "We've never done it that way before." These churches are often more wedded to tradition than what God actually commands.
- #10 SELFISHNESS: Members want things "my way." What's best for the church and its mission to reach the lost, is often replaced by personal preferences of individual members with a personal agenda for the church.

As the Cullman Church of Christ, I pray we will always be committed to removing any obstacles and barriers to church growth—the saving of people's souls, and replace them with the Spirit's leading.


Mission Update—Change of Plans
