FALL FEST

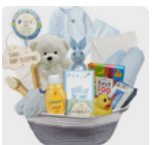

Mission Thanksgiving will take place over the next few weeks. Mission Thanksgiving will provide school children with a Thanksgiving meal (all non-perishable items) to have over the Thanksgiving Break. This year, the school chosen to receive these meals is Vinemont. We will be providing 1050 bags for the children in the elementary, middle, and high school. The bags will include a card written by the Greetings with Love Servant Group and an age appropriate Bible for each child. The principals of each of these schools have **asked that we put the Bible in the bag for each child.**

Things that will happen during Mission Thanksgiving are as follows:

1. Nov. 2 - Mission Thanksgiving has been included in the Harvest Sunday collection.
You can also give a check earmarked "Mission Thanksgiving" at any time in the collection plate or to the office. These monies will be used to purchase all the food and Bibles for all 1050 bags.
2. Nov. 2 - Nov. 15 - All items will be ordered ahead of time to fill the bags and will be placed in the Multipurpose room.
3. Nov. 15 - Saturday at 10am we will have a "Pack Day" to begin packing all 1050 of the bags through assembly line style. We ask that volunteers be at least 4th grade and older to come and help.
4. Nov. 16 - Finish up any packing not completed on Nov. 15.
5. Nov. 18, 19, and 20 - Delivery to each of the schools beginning with the elementary on the 18th. Volunteers will be needed to load bags into vehicles around lunch time and deliver to the kids close to school dismissal time. More details later.

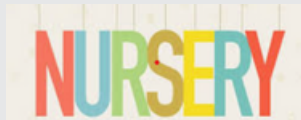

Parents: Please be sure to sign your child in each week. The sign-in sheet is located on the counter outside the attended nursery.

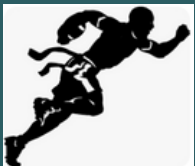

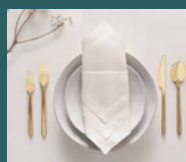
Area-Wide Devotional at Beltline Church of Christ on November 2 at 5:30 pm. We will meet at the bus at 4:30 pm to leave.
