Things that will happen during Mission Thanksgiving are as follows:

- 1. November 2 and after Mission Thanksgiving has been included in the Harvest Sunday collection. You can also give a check earmarked "Mission Thanksgiving" at any time in the collection plate or to the church office. These monies will be used to purchase all the food and Bibles for all 1050 bags.
- 2. Now November 15 All items are being ordered ahead of time to fill the bags and will be placed in the multipurpose room. These items have already started arriving.
- 3. November 15 Saturday at 10am we will have a "Pack Day" to begin packing all 1050 of the bags through assembly line style. We ask that volunteers be at least 4th grade and older to come and help. **There is a sign up sheet at the Information desk.**
- 4. November 16 Finish up any packing not completed on Nov. 15.
- 5. November 18, 19, and 20 Delivery to each of the schools will begin with the elementary on November 18. Volunteers will be needed to load bags into vehicles and deliver to the kids close to school dismissal time. Meet at the building at 10am each day.
