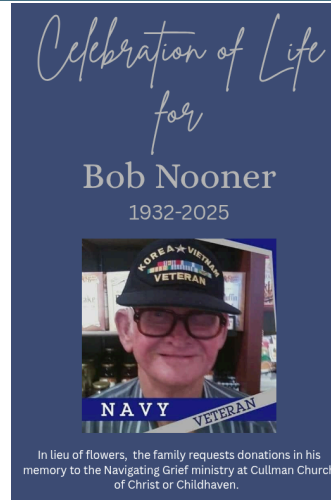
Laura Scott, friend of Leanne Hancock, is recovering from hip surgery and will be having two more surgeries on the same hip in the spring.

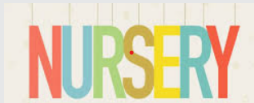
