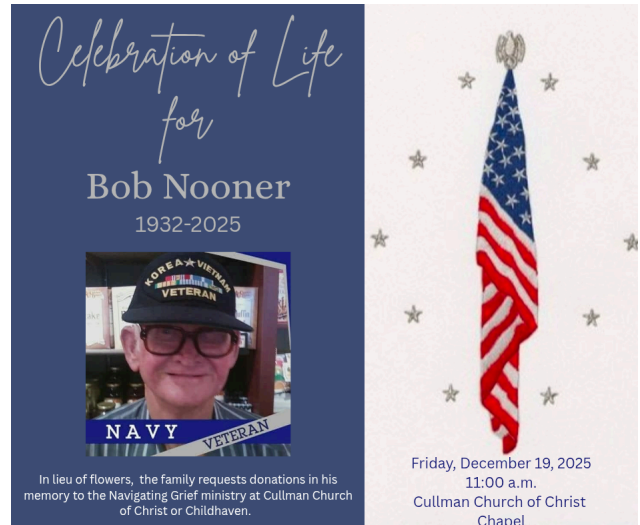
Laura Scott, friend of Leanne Hancock, is recovering from hip surgery and will be having two more surgeries on the same hip in the spring.

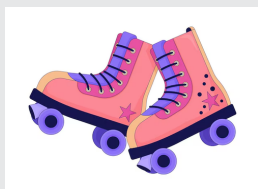

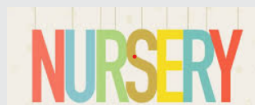


Reminder: We will not have Bible classes on Wednesday, December 24, Sunday, December 28, and Wednesday, December 31.
