Singing at the neighborhood will be **today, (December 7)**, January 4, and February 1, at 2:00pm. Everyone is welcome!

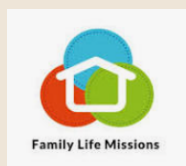

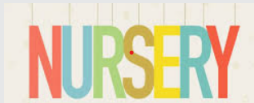
Today is the deadline! Family Life Missions Coin Bank Campaign concludes today. Please return coin banks to the information center.
