
Diaper & More Basket for Katie Lee



Our primary mission is to reach the unreached with the True gospel and New Testament Truth and Church which is purchased by His precious Blood. We are committed to reaching all the native villages for Christ with the gospel, but concentrate our efforts in the most remote areas, through our Preachers Training Schools for Ryali area, Hill Area and Tribal Areas where we are running our Bible Schools. Please continue all of your prayers for suitable building facilities, especially we need a dormitory for Trainee preachers for Ryali Preachers Training School, at first.

The Wendell J. Kelley Bible School training includes:

1. Basic Bible Training
2. Field Training under Brother Praveen Palanati, along with our staff and senior preachers and visit our well-established Congregations.
3. Advanced Bible Training.

Upon completing the program, the new graduates are sent into remote places of some here in India. They evangelize among the innumerable native villages scattered throughout their own communities, and regions.

Community Engagement:

Our Bible School is not just about academic learning; it's also about practical application. Students are encouraged to participate in outreach and ministry activities, so we need a special Bus for our Trainee Preachers.

Support Our Bible School: Your financial contributions help us provide resources, materials, and scholarships for students in need. Every gift helps us equip the next generation of Preachers and leaders, etc. Please continue your love and prayers for our India as we need some special funds to help and support our working preachers and newly established Congregations through our Trainee Preachers.

Special Request: All of our working congregational youth ask (Requesting) us, they would like to see the young missionaries from our Sponsoring Congregations.
