



### ✨ We Want to Share Stories of Hope ✨



If you feel led, please message() or text me (256-338-0265) your story (short or long!) and let me know if you'd like your name included or prefer to remain anonymous.





## **Education That Changes Generations Por Los Ninos Christian School**

**In Honduras, the school year runs from February through November, and this year we are welcoming over 110 students, from Pre-K through 10th grade. Each child who walks through our gates represents possibility — not only for their own future, but for their entire family.**

**At Family Life Missions, we understand the life-changing power of education. In a country where 16.6% of adults are illiterate, and over 60% of people have only a basic education, access to consistent schooling can be the difference between limitation and opportunity. School is required only through 6th grade, and many children never make it that far. Some leave as early as 2nd or 3rd grade to work or care for younger siblings.**

**But at Por Los Niños Christian School, a different story is unfolding.**

**Here, students receive a quality bilingual Christian education that prepares them academically, spiritually, and emotionally. And the impact reaches far beyond the classroom.**

**Each month, parents visit our campus for Parents School, where they learn about positive parenting, homework support, trauma care, nutrition, and more. They build friendships, strengthen their families, and grow together as a community. Once a year, those same parents return to serve — painting playgrounds, building sidewalks, and improving the campus — investing their own hands into their children's future.**

**This is transformation that touches generations.**

**Because of generous supporters, 54% of our students receive needs-based scholarships, making education possible for families who otherwise could not afford it.**

**Education changes a child.**
