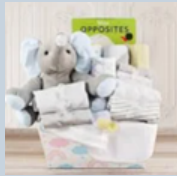

Whether you feel called to serve or need encouragement, both roles are valuable. Please pray about how God may be leading you to be involved.

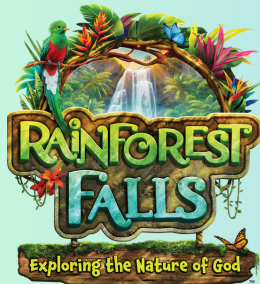

Senior Sunday will be May 3.

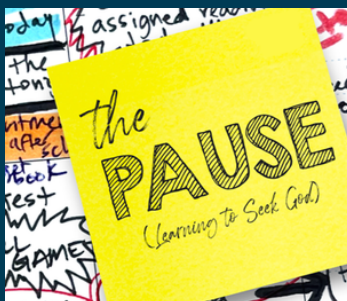
Parents/Guardians of Seniors: please submit 12-15 photos of your graduate from Birth-Current. The deadline for photos is April 19.

Laying Foundations of Hope

Rolando and Silvia have been married for 16 years. They are hardworking, faithful, and deeply committed to their boys—Rolando, 15, and Jafeth, 6. But like so many families in Catacamas, Honduras their reality has been shaped by limitation.

Rolando works as a welder, earning about \$175 a month. Silvia does whatever she can—sometimes making nacatamales to sell—to help provide for her family. For years, despite their efforts, they haven't been able to secure something many of us take for granted: A place to call their own. Recently, they took a brave step of faith and purchased a small piece of land. With the support of their church they began digging the foundation by hand. They began laying something deeper than concrete, a foundation—both physically and spiritually—for their family.

Through Family Life Missions Building Dreams program, a U.S. Mission Team, along with our FLM donors, will: Add a roof to protect them from the heavy rains Pour a concrete floor—a literal foundation beneath their feet Install doors, windows, and electricity Build a safe, indoor bathroom Provide health support and follow-up care And help Silvia begin a small business to support her family.

But just as important... Through their local church and our comprehensive care team, we are helping them build a spiritual foundation—one rooted in faith, community, and the love of Christ. Because lasting transformation always starts at the foundation. And when a family is grounded both physically and spiritually, it impacts generations.
