Mission Report from Jaya Paul

By the grace of God and the generosity from the Cullman Church of Christ, we are extending His kingdom and living out the Gospel in tangible ways in this pagan nation. We'll be stewarding it to bear good fruit and in advancing the saving Gospel.

Some of the Tribal Area Preachers work in very remote areas where the people do not have any medical or school facilities. They often have to walk about 10 to 25 kilometers through zigzag jungle trails to reach their working villages. Despite many trials and persecutions, churches are being established, and an increasing number of souls are being saved through our ministries here in India.

Our Church Building project has made a significant difference for the local congregations to grow spiritually and in number. When the congregation has its own facility to preach Christ with worship services and mid-week Bible classes, they can go forward without any fear from the outer communities or the owners of the rented homes.

Thousands are converted into Christ every year here in India unofficially due to our Indian Government issuing many restrictive rules about preaching Christ and regulations through the Anti-conversion Bill. Please continue to pray for the Tribal Area and Hill Area Preachers as many are in need of regular monthly support to meet immediate family needs in these critical situations. Many of these Christians are in desperate need for church buildings in all of our working congregations, including the Ryali Area, Hill Area and Tribal Area villages. A church building is significantly important because it becomes the focal point of the community and serves as a key mission station in the area. Moreover, it becomes more than just a place for Sunday worship. It would be used for all other church activities, such as charity purposes, Sunday School Projects, Special Bible Classes, and Gospel Meetings, as well as providing secular education.
