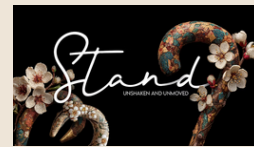

Family Life Missions Update

Building a Future For Two Families

1. Just five minutes from our Family Life Missions campus in Catacamas, a family is quietly building something extraordinary... one block at a time.

For the past four years, Franklin Varela has been working tirelessly to build a home for his family. With a monthly income of just \$340 from his maintenance job—and with his teenage son Erlin contributing what he can from construction work—they have managed to bring their home to about 45% completion. But right now, their future is at risk.

Erlin, their 14-year-old son, has stopped studying to help support the family. His heart is in the right place—but we know his story isn't meant to end there. Education opens doors that temporary income cannot. This is why FLM Building Dreams Program is about so much more than construction.

Yes, we will help complete their home—

a roof, floors, doors, windows, electricity, and a bathroom. But even more than that, we are **helping lay a spiritual and physical foundation** for this family:

A place where children can study.

A place where a mother can rebuild her business.

A place where dignity replaces survival.

A place where the family can grow, pray, and serve.

Because as **Isaiah 58:12** reminds us,

"You will be called the repairer of broken walls, the restorer of streets with dwellings."

That is exactly what is happening here. Franklin has already laid the blocks with his own hands. Now, together—with the local church, Family Life Missions, and the funds from Cullman Church of Christ's Harvest Sunday's "Honduran Building Project"—we can help complete what he started.

2. Rolando and Silvia have been married for 16 years. They are hardworking, faithful, and deeply committed to their boys—Rolando, 15, and Jafeth, 6. But like so many families we meet in Catacamas, their reality has been shaped by limitation.

Rolando works as a welder, earning about \$175 a month. Silvia does whatever she can—sometimes making nacatamales to sell—to help provide for her family. For years, despite their efforts, they haven't been able to secure something many of us take for granted: A place to call their own.

So today, they live with Rolando's mother.

But they didn't stop dreaming.

Recently, they took a brave step of faith and purchased a small piece of land. With the support of their church, they began digging the foundation by hand.

They began laying something deeper than concrete, a foundation—**both physically and spiritually—for their family.**

This is where you step into their story. **Through FLM Building Dreams program,** and the funds from Cullman Church of Christ's Harvest Sunday's "Honduran Building Project" we are coming alongside the Callejas family this summer to help complete their home-and strengthen the foundation they have already begun.
