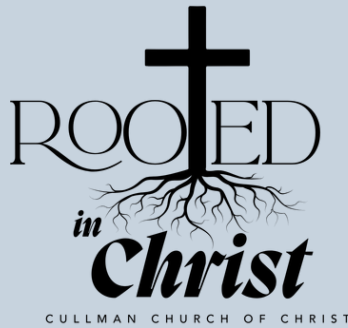

Why Does Family Life Missions Have a School?

In Honduras, the school year runs from **February through November**. So why does Family Life Missions invest so heavily in education? **Because education changes generations.**

In Catacamas, a rural community in Olancho where our campus is located, many children face barriers that make continuing their education difficult:

- **Many rural communities have no secondary school**, leaving students with nowhere to continue after 6th grade.
- “Free” **public education isn’t truly free**. Uniforms, textbooks, transportation, and other expenses can overwhelm families already struggling to meet basic needs.
- As a result, many children **leave school by age 12**.
- More than **16,000 public schools** lack adequate facilities, including running water, electricity, or desks.
- About **half of third-grade students** do not reach basic reading and math proficiency.
- Only about **32% of students** complete primary school without repeating a grade.

For many rural children, the dream of an education ends too soon. **That’s why Por Los Niños Christian School (PLNCS) exists.**

Educating the Whole Child

PLNCS currently serves students from Pre-K through 10th grade, adding one upper grade each year as we work toward a complete secondary education.

Students learn from Christian teachers in:

- Core Academics
- Bible
- Computer Technology
- Art
- Music
- Recreation

Our school is also a **trauma-informed environment**, recognizing that every child has unique experiences, incredible potential, and immeasurable value.

The **majority of our students receive scholarship support**, with tuition determined on a sliding scale based on each family’s individual needs.

Our goal is more than academic success. We want students to **grow spiritually, develop strong character, and become compassionate leaders who impact their families and communities for Christ**. Christian curriculum, daily Bible classes, and devotionals are an important part of that mission.

Strengthening Families

Our **Parents’ School** meets monthly, providing classes on emotions and communication, positive parenting, being a strong parent, growing up in the digital age, and more.

Our vision says it best:
