Dear Friends,

In our May 14th letter, we explained the various difficulties we were experiencing due to the perfect storm created by the COVID-19 pandemic, our inability to work because of it and various other factors. As I sit in front of my computer, this is one the most difficult letters I think I have ever attempted to draft because of the impact the Mission House had on the men who have gone through the program, the families that have been restored, and the other Mission Houses that have been opened using God's work in this place as a model. Yesterday, I finished moving our equipment, trucks, cars, trailers, and records from the house graciously provided by Noble Purposes Foundation. Since the Mission House restructuring and relaunch will take months to accomplish, leaving the house vacant for an undetermined period of time doesn't make sense. The Executive Director of the Christian Heritage Foundation and his family of eight are in need of a place to stay and continue their work. They will be temporarily moving into the house. It was so much fun to watch their children's reaction to God's provision. Pray for them, their ministry and success as they now have a light in the midst of darkness.

So, what is our plan going forward? As we stated in our last letter, "Even amidst this perfect storm of events, we believe the Lord is not finished using the Mission House to change the lives of men and their families". We are planning to diligently chart a path forward, search and pray for a new director and, Lord willing, re-launch the Mission House sometime in the spring of 2021.

For those who have supported the ministry, we would like to say thank you for the time, teaching, mentoring, provision and donations. We would ask you to prayerfully consider continuing your support for we will need teachers, mentors and the finances in order to relaunch in the spring of next year. It is reminiscent of how we started many years ago, planning in June for an April launch which the Lord moved to September. I can't wait to see what the Lord has in store this time!

I would like to thank Noble Purposes Foundation for coming alongside the Mission House, purchasing the home and their continuing efforts to support the Lord's ministry with the assets the Lord has provided to them.

As we said in our last letter, "Faith is easy when the road is charted, the way is safe, and all is seen. It becomes more difficult in times when the road is uncharted, needs to be cleared, and the way is unknown." We are moving forward in faith, believing the Lord will provide for all our needs and we long for the day when He will once again use the Mission House as a tool to change the lives of men and their families once again. "For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ."
