**The Call of Pentecost**

We are a people in mission and we must never lose sight of it.

Acts 1:1-8 NLT

Vs. 1 The first book (Luke) describes what Jesus “began” to do so this second book (Acts) is a continuation. The author, Luke reintroduces the main character “Holy Spirit.”

Vs. 3 Jesus is talking about the Kingdom of God, the focal point of His life and ministry.

Vs. 4 The game plan for Jesus’ kingdom agenda. This is not the first time the disciples heard about the Holy Spirit. Luke 3:16; 4:18-19

**Question:** Where else in Luke does it emphasize the Person and work of the Holy Spirit?

Vs. 6-7 It’s not our business to get caught up in end time speculation. Our business is vs. 8. It’s about God’s kingdom.

“Jesus’ last command must be our first priority.”

**Questions:** In what ways does end time speculation entangle people and pull them away from the mission? Have you ever been caught in this?

We believe that the book of Acts is for today. This is the foundation of our fellowship of churches called The Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada. The DNA of the PAOC is to engage in international mission.

“Maybe God is calling you ...” God calls people from churches like ours, not just somewhere else.

**Questions:** Is God calling you to go? Is God calling you to vocational ministry? What is God calling YOU to do? Are you called to send?

We are all called to live lives of extravagant generosity.

**Question:** In what ways have you grown in generosity?

The Spirit empowers us to do, say, or give more than we can do on our own.

**Question:** Have you experienced this? Explain ...

Familiarity with the Holy Spirit can breed casualness.

**Questions:** Do you need a fresh encounter with the Holy Spirit? What is the one step you will take towards igniting that fire again?
