



### From the Pastor's study,

It's spring, the flowers are blooming, the trees are budding, the grass is greening, the birds have returned from their winter homes, and we are seeing signs of life again among all of nature. You know why? Because it's Easter time, better known as "Resurrection of Christ." Just think, because of Easter, we have the greatest hope known to mankind and it's the kind of hope that is absolutely sure and can be counted on 100%, because it's about new life.

Jesus rose from the grave after being crucified on a cross, declared dead, buried and placed in a grave with a huge stone rolled in front of the entrance as His final resting place. No one escapes from their final resting place, except Jesus. Remember, the stone was placed in the entrance to keep Jesus in and to keep anyone else out from stealing the body. The stone was rolled away, not to let Jesus out, but to let others in to see that He really was gone. The power of God and His ability to raise Jesus from the dead would never be hindered by a little rock.

I want you to know and think about this. We live in a world that seemingly has gone crazy. The enemy has lied to millions of people and led them away from Jesus and has created a world that does not accept the truth of God's word and thus has caused chaos to become the norm. We have learned that the normal we once were used to will not be returning, but because of Resurrection Sunday, Jesus will be.

Because of the resurrection, we have hope in a hopeless world. Because of the resurrection, Jesus has validated every promise He has ever given us. Because of the resurrection, we no longer need to fear death nor the grave. Because the resurrection was predicted to happen by Old Testament prophets and Jesus Himself during the course of His time here on earth, we can rest assured it was ordained, designed, and proclaimed by God Himself.

You may be discouraged, depressed, downhearted, discontented, diffused, disgusted, diminutive, disappointed, disarrayed, discordant, (ok, I got carried away). Rest assured, if Jesus rose from the dead and then told you that you too will rise from the dead, (John 11:25-26) wouldn't that put to rest all of those anxious thoughts and worries?

If you've ever felt weak in faith or bereft of hope, you are not alone. It's not unusual to come to the Lord with requests for healing, financial security, or other solutions, only to find that the trials remain. We must remember, these trials have a short shelf life.

It's during these times we must remember to focus on God's timeless truths. Jesus told His disciples multiple times that He was going to be crucified and would rise again, but they never took this message to heart, it wasn't what they wanted to hear. (Matt. 20:17-19). So, they became upset when the events didn't turn out as they desired. This is what happens when we are looking for hope in the wrong places and not focusing on God's truth.

When Jesus arose from the dead, the disciples saw a seemingly hopeless situation turn into a miraculous triumph that lifted them from the depts of despair. If it did that for them, it will do it for you as well. No matter what in the world is going on, we have this one steadfast truth to hold onto that will carry us through the darkest of days, the difficulty of trials, the deepest of pain and suffering. Focus on the truth of Jesus and His resurrection and each day will bring joy and satisfaction to every heart.

I hope this helped put you in the mood for "Resurrection Sunday". It is the greatest day of celebration for all believers. Remember, Jesus always does what He says He will do. You can count on it. He is coming again, are you ready?


