Thoughts from Pastor Bill,

As I write to you all, I am smiling. I'm full of the joy of the Lord. When you see me most times, I am cheerful and happy with a smile on my face ready to give it to you just in case you don't have one for yourself. For the most part I am always a happy, joyful person. Don't talk to my wife, Diane, though. She will tell you a different story. I have my moments, just like you all do, but I try not to give you my burdens and save them all for the Lord. He is really good at handling them when I give them to Him.

You may wonder why I started this article this way. Let me bare my soul just for a few moments. It's been a tough struggle the past few weeks. Since last November, I have conducted eight funerals and attended another one as a friend. Most of those are from our church. I have conducted several hundred funerals and they are all experiences that have a tendency to take a drain on emotions. Many of these have been called a "Celebration of Life". That's a fairly new way of procedure for funeral homes to take and it seems to lighten the burden of grieving somewhat. Why do I give you all this information? Here is why. No matter how many years of life a person has been given, that in itself is not the most important thought to dwell on. What is important is how much "Life" you have put into the years you have been given.

To get the most out of life is to know your purpose and the meaning of your life. To know how to do this, you must get to know the One who has given you life. The One who knows the purpose and meaning of your life. We were created to have a relationship with our Creator and when we do, life takes on a different meaning and is filled with meaning and purpose. That's what He sent His Son to earth for. To open up a relationship between you and Himself.

I'm almost done here, just a few more lines. February is "Love" month. Do you know what it feels like to be loved? I hope you do. Do you know how it feels to be known as a person? I hope you do. Do you know what it feels like to love someone else? I hope you do. Here is the end of my story.

I am loved. Loved by my wife, my children, my

grandchildren, my church members, my friends. It feels good. I love them all as well. Even though their love is a great thing, the greatest is that I am loved by God because I am known by God. He knows me and my faults and He still loves me. I love the Lord as well. I'm getting to know Him better and as I do, I love Him more. He loves me so much I am invited into His Throne Room every day whenever I want to come (Hebrews 4:16) and have a conversation with my Creator. When I do, He teaches me more about Himself and He also teaches me about myself. I am known by my God and what a joy that gives me to know that I am known and loved at the same time by the One who created everything. (Colossians 1:16) As a result, I'm getting to know myself better and that's a good thing.

He'll do the same for you all because God so loved the world. Happy Valentines Day!


