



From the Pastor's Heart,

I often wonder what I should write about each month and many times it is difficult to know what to say to you all. Most days of my life I am upbeat, happy, joyful, and excited about ministry and

hearing from people of how God is at work in their life. Right now, I'm thinking of those in our church who are graduating this year from high school and college and entering into a new phase of life. I am thinking about some new pastors who have just started ministry in some of our associational churches. About a pastor friend of mine who just joined the staff at the Central Kentucky Baptist Association, (CKNB). This is all good stuff, happy stuff, joyful stuff.
