From the Pastor's Desk,

This past month of February 2022, I recalled an old song we used to sing as I was incapacitated from the pulpit. It goes like this, "If the world from you withholds of its silver and its gold, and you have to get along with meager fare, just remember, in His Word, how He feeds the little birds; take you burden to the Lord, leave it there. Now if your body suffers pain and your health you can't regain, and your soul is slowly sinking in despair, Jesus knows the pain you feel, He can save and He can heal take your burden to the Lord, leave it there. Take your burden to the Lord and leave it there."

I did this every day in the month of February while struck with the covid virus. I dare say it was a tough month. However, I was reminded through the reading of His word that God never wastes an experience that He allows to come into our lives. It was not good to be infected with what I thought I would escape when dealing with this pesky virus for two years and then pow! Diane and I both got it. But as God always does, He works all things together for the good. (Romans 8:28)

We started a 21 days of Breakthrough Prayer endeavor on February 7th. I didn't realize that at that time God was going to set me aside for all of those 21 days to listen, review, renew and restore my prayer life all by myself. It was a challenge and even though I fought it for a few days while sick, God begin to reveal things to me that I needed to be reminded of. I had a series of messages developed on prayer that I was going to use for the month of February. I got one of them preached and then it was shut down time for me from preaching but it was open my mind and heart time in my personal time with the Lord.

I don't have the space to write to you all that I experienced in the month of February so let me just share this one in hopes that it will encourage you and strengthen your walk with Jesus. In Matthew 6:6 Jesus says, "But you, when you pray, go into your closet, close your door and pray to your Father who is in secret and your Father who sees

what is done in secret will reward you." That closet space is the place where you spend time with God alone. It's where you get to speak to the Lord but also to listen to Him as He speaks to you. Here is what has come out of my closet. In the stillness of those many days when I determined to spend more time in His word and more time in prayer, God reminded me of this one thing that I really did know but had not given it the thoughtfulness I should have. God loves to hear from me. God loves to spend time with me one on one. He treasures those moments when it's just Him and me getting alone together and Him listening to my heart and then me being silent and listening to His heart. I have to be honest with you all, I had not been spending as much time alone with my Savior as I should have been. I never would have realized this unless He had set me aside for those few days and got my undivided attention. Since the first of the year, I have been faithfully reading a scheduled outline of various scriptures, New Testament and Old and it has been inspiring.

Here is what is happening. My prayer life is changing. As I read the book of Colossians, there were over thirty places where I was led to stop and pray the truth that I was reading about. You see, prayer is the very foundation of our relationship with the Lord. It is the path of communing with our Creator. It is absolutely essential to maintain not only a vibrant walk with the Lord but it's critical to the depth of understanding how the power of God works in our life. Prayer empowers us to do the will of God by aligning us with His will. Prayer is necessary if we are to obey the message in John 15:5, "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me, and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing." Through prayer, we abide in Jesus. I am not called to produce fruit on my own. I am called to abide as a branch connected to the source that allows me to bear much fruit. A branch by itself cannot produce fruit. Through prayer I stay in the abiding mode and then through this obedience, God produces the fruit.

Praying the truth of God's Word to become activated in our lives is what gives us the capability of producing fruit that brings honor and glory to the Kingdom of God. You want to produce much fruit? Then you must spend much time abiding in Jesus by bathing yourself in the truth He has given to us.

This may not mean much to you all, after all it's my experience, not yours. But if I can just give you a moment of encouragement that just might jump start your prayer life to another level, then my experience just might become yours as well. I do not know how God is going to use this in my life but one thing I do know. If I don't keep my spirit fed with the power of God's word, I will not be able to do what Jesus told Peter to do in John 21:16, "Shepherd my sheep." I can't lead you to greener pastures unless I know where they are. In God's words of truth, they are really green and rich and very nourishing. I am praying I will do more grazing in those green pastures and then help you to get there too, if you're not already there.

We are on a spiritual journey throughout our entire life. Make the journey a joyful one by sitting with the Master who designed the journey for us. God bless you as you travel.

ANNIE ARMSTRONG (1850-1938)



Annie Armstrong was born in Baltimore at a time when women were not expected to lead. She served, challenged churches to action and rallied support for missionaries. Ultimately, Annie was recognized as a national Southern Baptist trailblazer renowned for visionary missions leadership.

Contributions

- Started Bay View Mission for Baltimore's poor and addicted
- Served as the first executive of Woman's Missionary Union
- · Raised support for missionaries to Italian and Jewish immigrants
- · Initiated fund-raising "brick cards" to build churches in Cuba
- · Gained support for the first black, female missionaries
- Secured funds to relieve China missionary, Lottie Moon, who had served for 11 years without a furlough
- · Advocated for Native Americans and impoverished mountain people
- Traveled across America in the late 1800s encouraging missionaries and inspiring churches to pray, give and act
- Honored in 1934 when The Home Missions Offering was re-named for her to encourage more to follow her sacrificial example
