



"The Faith" Is "Your Faith"

An Excerpt from The Catholic Parent's Survival Guide written by Julianne Stanz

Once after I gave a talk to a group of parents about simple but important ways they could help their children grow in faith, a man named David approached me. "I have five children at the moment ranging in age from 8 months to 10 years," he said. He then asked a very important question: "what's the best way to pass on the faith to children?" Read David's question once again. Now does anything strike you about the guestion?

When I was reflecting upon this conversation later, it struck me that many of us ask the same question using the exact same words: "How do I pass on the faith to my children?" The key lies in the phrase "the faith." How many times have you heard people talk about "the faith." How often have you used the phrase "the faith" to describe your own faith life?

Many times we talk about faith as if it were a product or a commodity. We speak of faith as if we were passing along a manual of instructions rather than a living relationship with God. "Hey, son (or daughter)! Read this and you will have "the faith" seems to be the implication for our young people. The expression "the faith" often implies an impersonal product that we can pass along rather than a living, breathing, and changing relational dynamic.

For Catholics, study and education about our faith are tremendously important, but ultimately faith is a lived relationship with God, and it's a way of life. Faith means nurturing a personal relationship with Christ, who is the same "yesterday and today and forever" and living out that relationship through our Catholic faith. It's important to remember that we are sharing not just the message of Christ but also his very person. Jesus is the Good News, and while faith can certainly be "taught," it is more often "caught," as the next little story underscores nicely.

This book is a great read, it gives straight answers to your kids' toughest Questions. It is written by Julianne Stanz, she has ministered in the Diocese of Green Bay and is a consultant to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in the areas of youth, evangelization, and catechesis. 

eight Afghans. Their stories and chilling accounts of escaping Afghanistan are the basis for the personal exhibition. The Afghans interviewed for the exhibit challenged the stereotypical image of Afghanistan depicted in the news. Serving Our Neighbors with Your Support

Here's what we've been up to:

We meet every second Sunday to pray, reflect on the Gospel, and report on how we've helped people in need.

Because of your generous support—through both donations and shopping at the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift & Furniture Store—the Oshkosh Council is able to provide \$6,000 every month to each of our three parishes: St. Raphael, Most Blessed Sacrament, and St. Jude. The combined \$18,000 from all three conferences helps an average of 40 to 60 families each month.

For the Quarter ending in June, St. Raphael Conference received 53 applications for assistance. We helped 44 families with money for rent and utilities totaling \$18,374. We also provided \$400 to the Frederico Ozanam Orphanage in Chilca, Peru.

Families are also referred to other organizations for additional financial support as well as job training, budgeting, child care, etc.

When you donate items (furniture, clothing, household goods) to the Store; Some items go directly to families in need through vouchers, other items are sold to fund our outreach.


