Dear Parishioners,

Blessed 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time! We are in the dog days of summer. School is right around the corner and things are about to ramp up. In this light, I was struck by a line in our second reading for this weekend. "Let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus."

As a former track athlete and current runner, I enjoy racing. There are many beautiful parallels to running a race and the Christian life. Perhaps this is why the author of Hebrews uses this analogy. Christ is our ultimate goal. We want to arrive at union with Him. We are racing, running towards him. That said, this race is not a sprint! The Christian life is a slow process of ridding ourselves of burdens and sins. This takes place through daily prayer, the sacrament of confession, and Christian Community (very important!).

Running gets easier when you do it regularly, just like **prayer**. Every few weeks, you need to change it up and do a different workout. This is like **confession**. Finally, going for a run is much more enjoyable when done with friends. Likewise, we need **Christian community** if we will ever effectively arrive at Christ. As the school year approaches, I encourage you to dive into these three practices and so persevere in running the race towards Christ.

St. John Vianney is the patron saint of parish priests and confessors. St. John Vianney spent his life building the Church through his ministry as a parish priest.





Infant Baptism

Infants accept the faith through the faith of their parents. Our parish offers group sessions to prepare parents for the baptism ceremony and for leading their children in a life of faith. Sessions are held twice per month, all year round. It may be easier to participate in a session before the child is born. Please call or email to register for the Baptism Preparation session and to schedule your child's baptism.

Contact Jill Eaton at 920-233-8044, jill.eaton@raphael.org There is one session for the first child, and a different session for the second child. Once parents have completed both sessions, they do not need to repeat for subsequent children.

One Catholic godparent is needed, who must be a Confirmed, practicing Catholic at least 16 years of age. If there are two godparents, there should be one male and one female. There should not be more than two godparents. A non-Catholic Christian may serve as a Christian witness in addition to the Catholic godparent.



THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY INTO HEAVEN

A Special Feast Day

The Assumption of Mary is also known as the Falling Asleep of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is celebrated every year on August 15.

We celebrate when our Blessed Mother was taken up into Heaven body and soul at the end of her life. On November 1, 1950 Pope Pius XII declared the doctrine of the Assumption:

"By the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

What is the difference between the Ascension and the Assumption? Jesus ascended. Mary was assumed. Because Jesus is God, He went up into Heaven by His own power. Mary, however, is a creature. She is not God. She could not ascend to heaven by her own power. So, she was assumed—taken up into heaven.

Even though Mary was assumed into Heaven, she is always with us. Heaven is our home and Mary wants us to be with her and her Son for all eternity. On the Solemnity of the Assumption, let us remember our Mother who is in Heaven and who loves us very much. The Assumption is the fourth Glorious Mystery in the Rosary. So every time we pray the Rosary we can remember that she is always with us and that she loves us more than anyone else on earth could!

"Mary, give me your heart: so beautiful, so pure, so immaculate: your Heart so full of love and humility that I may be able to receive Jesus in the Bread of Life and love Him as you love Him and serve Him in the distressing guise of the poor."

Beautiful Hope Book Discussion



"World Relief Fox Valley and the History Museum at the Castle (in Appleton) partnered to make the exhibition possible. Staff from World Relief and the History Museum worked together conducting oral history interviews with

eight Afghans. Their stories and chilling accounts of escaping Afghanistan are the basis for the personal exhibition. The Afghans interviewed for the exhibit challenged the stereotypical image of Afghanistan depicted in the news. Our Afghan Neighbors also shows the connections between local, national, and international history." (From the History Museum at the Castle website)




