

As friends and followers of Jesus, we are devoted to fostering households and communities of discipleship through the mission and ministry of the Catholic Church.




#### Dear Parishioners,

Our faith is meant to be very concrete. Our faith is meant to shape how we live each day, how we make decisions both big and small. They say you can tell a lot about a person by looking at their calendar and their bank account. How do we spend our time? How do we spend our money?

Today's Gospel passage ends with Jesus' statement "You cannot serve both God and mammon." Let's allow this challenge to sink in. How are we going to spend this Sunday, the Lord's Day? Have we done any service for others this week? Have we donated to a charity or a person in need? Have we prayed today? Have we listened to someone who needed to talk? Have we included the Church and charities in our will and estate planning?

Most of us are pretty good at noticing what other people need to change. Perhaps today we can pray about how Jesus is calling us to change. How does the Lord want us to prioritize our time and resources? He challenges us because He loves us. What is one thing Jesus may be asking of us today?



One way that you could help our parish is to prayerfully consider remembering the parish in your estate planning. For those who have children, Bishop Ricken encourages people to consider treating their parish as an additional child.

As a relatively young parish (less than 50 years old), St. Raphael has less money put aside for future use. For example, the other two parishes have significantly more investments than our parish. As with our personal investments, the church's investments are a source of future income for future ministry needs.

Please remember to include our parish and other charities in your estate planning. It will certainly make a difference for the good!

#### WHAT IS YOUR GIFT AND HOW CAN YOU **USE IT TO SERVE OTHERS?**

As a longtime volunteer, then part-time employee and now full-time employee here at St. Raphael, I have learned that many of our parishioners attend Mass on Sunday without ever taking time to register in the parish until they need something: a sacrament, an education at Lourdes Academy, a priest to visit a sick relative, or even sadly a funeral. Take the time to register in the parish this week and get to know more about our church. Ask a staff member or the priest after Mass for a welcome folder.

The priests I've known and worked with have so many responsibilities on their plates these days. But the care of their flock is among their highest priorities. They want to get to know your family and in return you can assure them of your support and service.

I believe that the way to make your parish community feel like a faith family is to seek out opportunities to serve that family. Just as we as parents show our love to our own families by sharing our gifts with them, we can share our skills, abilities, and time with our fellow parishioners.

#### **Empty Cisterns**



"Two evils my people have done: they have forsaken me, the source of living waters; They have dug themselves cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water." - Jeremiah 2:13

With these words, the Old Testament prophet Jeremiah captures God's lament for the state of his people. They have abandoned him, the true source of life and

joy, and instead are relying upon themselves. The Lord calls out the futility of their attempts. A broken cistern cannot hold water for long. Eventually, it will run dry as the water drains through its cracks.

As we enter into this series of reflections on emptiness and abundance, we begin with this stark contrast between the abundance of God's living, life-giving water and broken cisterns that continually run dry. Jesus will one day draw upon this metaphor when he says in John's Gospel:

"Let anyone who thirsts come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as scripture says: 'Rivers of living water will flow from within him." - John 7:37b-38

There is only One who is the source of life, only One who can fill us, satisfy our thirst, and meet our deepest needs, and that is God alone. But we are often like the Israelites. We dig our cisterns and think we can meet our own needs. Maybe our cistern is a relationship, maybe it's success or the approval of others, maybe it's sports or a job or a dream we are pursuing for our future. Whatever it is, we might be able to drink from it for a while. It might satisfy us temporarily. But eventually we'll notice that it can't hold water. When we are thirsty and run to it to fill us up, we will find that it's bone dry.

This moment is actually one of great grace, although it can be painful. It is better to realize that our own efforts to satisfy our thirst are empty than to keep trying and failing forever. When we realize the ultimate emptiness of our efforts to fill ourselves, we are in just the right place to receive true abundance.

Let us remain in the heart of Jesus and pray for one another!
