

MISSION OF ST. RAPHAEL


As friends and followers of Jesus, we are devoted to fostering households and communities of discipleship through the mission and ministry of the Catholic Church.

Dear Parishioners,

Christ is King of the Universe. It was 100 years ago (1925) that Pope Pius XI established this feast, which is now celebrated on the last Sunday of the liturgical year, the Sunday before Advent.

Pope Pius XI established this Solemnity to counter a growing secularism and atheism. In the past century, many forces have been at work to remove faith and God from public life. Entire governments in different parts of the world have attempted to do this, as has our increasingly secular culture.

As we celebrate Christ as King, we declare Christ to be the one who is in charge of our lives, our country, our world and the entire universe. We do not give that role to anyone else. We invite Christ to be part of each and every part of our lives, our personal decisions, and the policies of any nation's government. Ultimate Truth does not come from any particular political or philosophical point of view or any celebrity or politician. Ultimate Truth comes from Christ Jesus, who has revealed God the Father to us.



In our own lives, we live this reality out as we allow Christ to have control of our lives. Each time we pray the Our Father prayer, we ask that “thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”


We begin with our own decision to follow Christ. As we grow in faith, we more and more allow Christ to lead us. We desire to follow God's will, not our own. We turn our lives over to God. When we and others do this individually, we help form our society and culture to do this as well.

- Paper crib craft for children



No single practice is likely to ensure that our children will grow hearts of gratitude. Like most habits, gratefulness must be continually cultivated. We take time during the Thanksgiving holiday to give thanks for things in our lives that we hope we are exercising thankfulness for throughout the year.

Our faith calls us to ask: How would things look different from the viewpoint of gratitude? My actions might be altered if they come from a mindset of abundance rather than scarcity. Do I see my position, money and power as a payoff for my individual effort? I may have gained some privileges purely by being born into my time, place and family. Who are the people who have supported my endeavors or paved the way for my success or situation in life?

These questions could spark interesting dinner table discussion for families with teenagers. Parents talking about these things will most likely experience trickle-down benefits in their children. Families with preschoolers will want to start with basic conversations prompting little ones to identify God's gifts in their lives.

Here are a few ideas to help your children learn the habit of gratitude:

Keep a Blessing Book.

Each night before bed, family members write down things they are thankful for. As you fill the pages, you'll have a growing record of god's providence in your life.

Limit TV and Shopping Trips

Children and adults are influenced by commercials and social media ads designed to create feelings of desire, dissatisfaction and need. The more time we spend in a store the more likely we are to find something "we need" to buy.

Expose your Children to the World

Take your children to volunteer at a local food bank or homeless shelter. If you can take a family trip to see how people live in other parts of the world. Involve your teens in some experience with the underprivileged. Here at our parish we have done, and will continue, to do mission trips for high schoolers and middle schoolers.



This year think about making Thanksgiving more than just a holiday; make it a way of life!

Our Jubilee Year of Hope Guest Speaker Series welcomes our final guest, Dr. Robin Goldsmith, President and Chief Medical Officer of **St. Gianna Clinic**.

Located in De Pere, the St. Gianna Clinic provides faith-centered health care that abides by the teachings of the Catholic faith. Areas of specialty include women's care, pediatrics, family medicine, infertility/fertility planning, and psychiatry. Our church is open during the daytime almost every day of the year. Evening times vary based on scheduled events. You are welcome to spend time in prayer in the church or in our Eucharistic

Chapel (in back of church). Praying with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament (tabernacle) is unlike praying in any other location because of the real presence of Christ.

Infant Baptism

Infants accept the faith through the faith of their parents. Our parish offers group sessions to prepare parents for the baptism ceremony and for leading their children in a life of faith. Sessions are held twice per month, all year round. It may be easier to participate in a session before the child is born. Please call or email to register for the Baptism Preparation session and to schedule your child's baptism.

Contact Jill Eaton at 920-233-8044, ext 222 jill.eaton@raphael.org There is one session for the first child, and a different session for the second child. Once parents have completed both sessions, they do not need to repeat for subsequent children.

One **Catholic godparent** is needed, who must be a **Confirmed, practicing Catholic** at least 16 years of age. If there are two godparents, there should be **one male and one female**. There should not be more than two godparents. A non-Catholic Christian may serve as a Christian witness in addition to the Catholic godparent.

Opportunities to **PRAY** for Others

Do you believe that God answers our prayers? Do you often find that praying is the most helpful thing you can do for another person? We invite you to share the gift of prayer with our parish community. We have two opportunities.

Prayer Chain

Prayer Chain members pray for special needs within our parish and beyond. Members will receive an email or phone call as requests arise (but not more than once a day). Members may pray however they feel led for these requests. It is a hidden, beautiful labor of love. We may never hear how God works to answer our prayers, but we trust he is doing good things.

Intercessory Prayer Team

Training will be provided, and you would be able to shadow a current team member. This commitment is based on what works for your schedule and is usually not more than about 10 minutes after Mass. The reward of praying for another far outweighs the brief time commitment!





Make Your IRA Charitable Rollover Gift

Did you know you can reduce your taxes by making a gift from your IRA directly to charity? If you are 70 1/2 years old or older, you can make a charitable gift up to \$108,000 directly from your IRA. This direct distribution can be made to a qualified charity such as your parish, a Catholic school, the Bishop's Appeal, a diocesan ministry, the Catholic Foundation, or another Catholic charity.



An IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution (**QCD**) gift is an easy way to help fulfill our Church's mission and reduce your taxable income. Your gift may qualify for your IRA required minimum distribution (**RMD**) which starts at the age of 73. Also, you will not have to pay federal income tax on the amount given directly from your IRA to a charity. **QCDs** made directly from your IRA are not subject to income tax and beneficial for those that cannot claim itemized deductions.

Here is how the **QCD** works:

1. You must be 70 1/2 years of age.
2. Your gift must come from an IRA (not a TSA or 401k).
3. Your gift is a **direct** transfer to a qualified charity such as St. Raphael Parish and the Catholic Foundation.
4. The maximum amount you can transfer is \$108,000. For a married couple filing jointly, each spouse may be able to make a gift for a potential of \$216,000.

To qualify as an IRA **QCD** or **RMD**, your gift must be made by December 31, 2025.

It is also important not to withdraw funds prior to making your gift. Instead, distribute the funds directly from your IRA to the qualified charity. If you would like your donation reflected on your year-end statement, please ask your Financial Advisor to include your name on the documentation.

We encourage families interested in making a QCD to speak with their financial advisor. For more information about how you can benefit from a QCD, please contact your IRA administrator and/or tax preparer. Please consider a QCD from your IRA to St. Raphael Parish, the Catholic Foundation, the Bishop's Appeal, or other Catholic charity. Make your gift as soon as possible to avoid any processing delays at the end of December, and don't miss the opportunity to make your IRA QCD this year! 
