Pastor Updates

- Accountant/Business Manager Mark Lindekugel is retiring after 18 years end of June. He works 24 hours a week. 2/3 is accounting and 1/3 as assigned. Informing the parish in the bulletin this weekend.
 - o Su van Houwelingen is the chair of the Finance Council and will work with Fr. Tom on hiring
- St. Jude Sacred Heart location is removing Sacred Heart school and will be building an Adoration chapel where the school is currently located. It will cost ~ \$1 million paid by St. Jude.
- New Goal of Bishop Ricken increase Mass attendance, reclaim Sunday
 - o Recent Goals
 - increase number of seminarians to 30 by fall 2025. Currently at 24.
 - Form and train at least a 1,000 Missionary Disciples measured by completing the Entrust Retreat. This has been met.
 - The new goal is focused on increasing Mass attendance and honoring Sunday

Lourdes update

Dave's been on the board since September 2024

Dave's three kids went through Lourdes and been away for ~7 years and returning showed how many positive changes. President John Dinegan is very engaged and staff does great with faith formation. Financially is good with a strong reserve. Increased health costs through diocese expecting a >10% increase. A lot of excitement with Girls Basketball going to State – the coach Ally Starr led a rosary and a kid made the rosary with basketball beads. There's an ELC (Early Learning Center) that's been approved in the old Citizens First Building...Capital campaign will cover this and expansion of the Sports complexes (football, baseball, softball) is in a quiet period right now...this will be much more business sponsorship focused. 30% our church support (and MBS and St. Jude) goes to Lourdes and this represents ~ 20% of Lourdes revenue.
