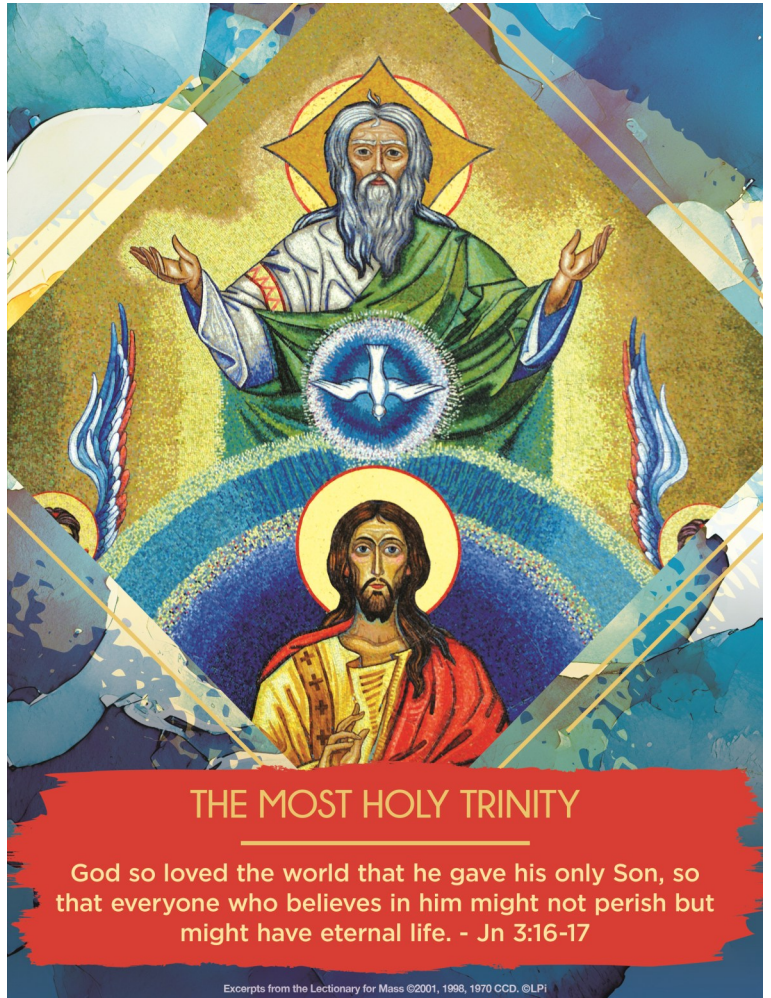

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



May is the month dedicated to Mary. This month to celebrate Mary, each week we will focus on a different apparition, the key details for kids, and the ways in which families can live Mary's message. This weekend we will focus on Our Lady of Champion

Marian Apparition: Our Lady of Champion

About the Apparition: Our Lady of Champion (formerly Our Lady of Good Help) is the first and only Church-approved Marian apparition in the United States. Occurring in 1859 in Champion, Wisconsin (just 50 miles north of Oshkosh), Mary appeared to a young Belgian immigrant named Adele Brise. Mary appeared as a beautiful woman in a dazzling white dress with a bright yellow sash tied around her waist. She had blonde hair with a crown of 12 glittering stars above her head. After identifying herself as Queen of heaven she gave Adele the mission to "gather the children... and teach them their catechism".

Key Details for Kids:

The Message and the Mission: Mary's message to Adele Brise shows God's great love for children. Mary's exact words to Adele were: *"Gather the children of this wild country and teach them what they should know for salvation. Teach them their catechism... Go and fear nothing, I will help you."*

The Faith: The core of this apparition is focused on the importance of knowledge and understanding of the Catholic faith. Mary stressed that children should learn their prayers, like the Sign of the Cross and have an understanding of the importance and power of receiving the sacraments.

The Miracle: In 1871, a massive forest fire (the Peshtigo Fire) swept through the region. People fled to the chapel on the shrine grounds with a statue of Mary, praying the rosary. The fire completely surrounded the property but miraculously did not cross into the grounds, sparing everyone inside, while the surrounding area was destroyed by the fire.

3 Ways to Live the Message:

- **Eat Waffles:** Since the Champion, Wisconsin area has deep Belgian roots, bake authentic Belgian desserts together as a family. You can make thick, fluffy Belgian waffles covered in strawberries and whipped cream. Before you eat the waffles, say a Hail Mary together to thank Our Lady of Champion for her care and protection.
- **Go on Pilgrimage:** The National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion is only a 60 minute drive from Oshkosh. The grounds and oratory are open 7am-7pm. Visit championshrine.org to plan your visit or to learn more.
- **Pray:** Say the following Prayer to Our Lady of Champion this week for someone you know who is in need:
- Dear Lady of Champion, you revealed yourself as the Queen of Heaven to your servant Adele. You gave her a mission to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to others, especially children. Like Adele, I trust that you are calling me to holiness. I ask you to hear the longings of my heart as I pray for _____.

Dear Lady, you said "Do not be afraid; I will help you." Please help me now by bringing my intention to your Son, Jesus. Amen.

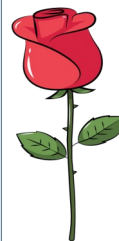

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi



Sunday, June 7 is the Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We celebrate the real presence of the Body and Blood, Soul

and Divinity of Jesus in the Eucharist. Thomas Aquinas proposed the Feast of Corpus Christi to Pope Urban IV, in order to create a feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist, emphasizing the joy of the Eucharist being the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

One of the ways we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi is with a Eucharistic Procession that all of the Oshkosh parishes will take part in. The Corpus Christi procession is a centuries old tradition of the Catholic faith to process the Real Presence of Jesus in public. The Blessed Sacrament is placed in a monstrance (a sacred vessel that displays the sacred host). The Blessed sacrament is then carried out of the church and through the streets of the neighborhood sometimes accompanied by songs and prayers.

Your families are invited to join the procession! The St. Raphael procession will start at 2pm at church (rain or shine) and follow a Witzel avenue route to Lourdes Academy. You are encouraged to join us at whatever point of the route would be best for you.

Benediction is at 3pm at Lourdes.



There will be a bus to return to St. Raphael.

Summer Catholicism 101: Encountering Jesus in the Gospel of John

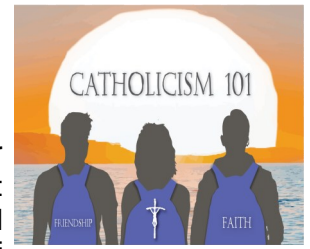

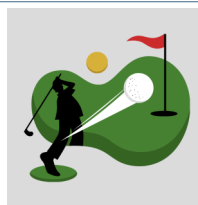

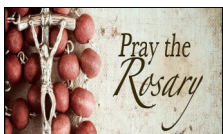
