Dear Parishioners,

Happy Sunday! Our scripture readings today encourage us to be leaders and to be counter-cultural at times for the sake of our faith.

One of the ways Bishop Ricken serves us as a courageous leader is his new goal to **Reclaim Sunday** for worship, rest and charitable service. As we have gotten away from the special character of Sunday over the course of the past 50 years or so, it has had negative effects on all of us. We are less committed to Sunday as a day of renewal. Sunday is meant to deepen our commitment to God and to others. The worship, rest and charitable service that is meant to be the core of the Lord's Day is good for our bodies and souls as the rest renews us in who we are called to be.

Volunteering as an expression of your Catholic faith

The Catholic Church considers volunteering a profound expression of faith, charity, and missionary discipleship. Rather than just unpaid labor, it views volunteering as a grace from God and a practical way to live out the Gospel mandate to love one's neighbor and serve those in need. Jesus calls us to be engaged with the world, engaged with the joys and the suffering of others. Volunteering can allow us to venture beyond your individual bubble and build a deeper sense of community.

There are many ways to volunteer here at St. Raphael either individually or as a family. Your family could volunteer to help with the donuts on Sunday morning or the Cookie social on Saturday night. Middle school and high school students can volunteer to be group leaders or Assistants for VBS which is August 3-7 this year.

One great need that we have for volunteers is with CLOW (Children's Liturgy of the Word). CLOW happens on Sunday mornings during the 10am Mass time. Children leave before the readings and return after the Homily. We need one adult leader (18 or older) and one or two assistants (14 or older) each week. It takes about 20 minutes and all materials and directions are provided. Please prayerfully consider volunteering for this ministry. The more leaders we get the better! **It is so important for our little disciples to understand God's message for them!** If you have questions or would like to sign up please contact Kathy Baehman at kathy.baehman@raphael.org or call the parish office.

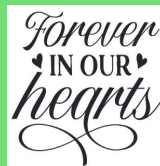

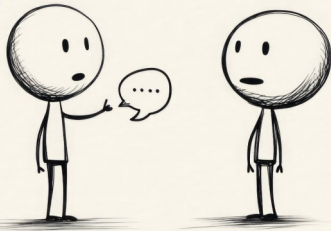

Infant Baptism

Infants accept the faith through the faith of their parents. Our parish offers group sessions to prepare parents for the baptism ceremony and for leading their children in a life of faith. Sessions are held twice per month, all year round. It may be easier to participate in a session before the child is born. Please call or email to register for the Baptism Preparation session and to schedule your child's baptism.

Contact Jill Eaton at 920-233-8044, ext 222 jill.eaton@raphael.org There is one session for the first child, and a different session for the second child. Once parents have completed both sessions, they do not need to repeat for subsequent children.

One **Catholic godparent** is needed, who must be a **Confirmed, practicing Catholic** at least 16 years of age. If there are two godparents, there should be **one male and one female**. There should not be more than two godparents. A non-Catholic Christian may serve as a Christian witness in addition to the Catholic godparent.
