Dear Parishioners,

It is hard to believe how quickly time flies! I already have over a month of ministry under my belt and it feels like only yesterday that I arrived! Thank you again for your warm welcome and assistance as I get to know all of you and continue to familiarize myself with the inner workings of our parish.

Today in the Book of Kings, we listen with the Prophet Elijah for the voice of the Lord. How did he speak to Elijah? He did not speak in the earthquake or the wind or in the fire as we might expect. Rather, Elijah goes to meet the Lord in "a tiny whispering sound." Just as the Lord revealed himself and spoke to his Prophet in the quiet of a cave, so too, he comes to us in the quiet of our hearts, speaking to us in the quiet whispering of his Spirit.

In our world today, we are constantly being inundated by noise. It is amazing that we can go from the time we wake up until the time we fall asleep and never have to experience a single moment of silence. For most of us, podcasts, YouTube, social media, TikTok, texting, emails, and more are just a tap away; in most public spaces and businesses, music is often playing in the background. Suffice it to say that listening to the voice of God in our hearts is difficult in such an environment.

Aware of this, Bishop Ricken has asked us as a Diocese to cultivate a "Culture of Vocations." Throughout the Diocese, we have different opportunities for our young people to step out of the noise of the world to more easily hear the call of Christ in their hearts, including Catholic Youth Expeditions, Camp Tekekwitha, and trips to conferences like SEEK and Steubenville.

Shortly after my ordination to the Priesthood, I took a trip to Rome with some of my seminary classmates. While I was there, I ran into some familiar faces: Fr. Ben Pribbenow, Fr. Mark Mleziva, Fr. Ryan Starks, and a dozen high school boys from our Diocese! I learned they were all young men very seriously discerning entering the seminary and were on a ten-day pilgrimage in the Eternal City to intensely discern their vocation in the heart of the Church. Their trip was made possible for these men because of the Raising Vocations Collection. Let us all pray for the young men and women of St. Raphael, that they may hear the voice of Christ---that "tiny whispering sound"---in their hearts, and follow him with faith and courage to live out their vocation, their call.

The Heavenly Hero for the month of August is **Saint Edith Stein**. Her religious name, Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, means "Blessed by the Cross," and her ultimate motto was "Hail to the Cross, our only hope." To celebrate her, gather your children around your family crucifix. Place flowers, a lit candle, or a small yellow rose (symbolic of Carmelite spirituality) near it. Each day this week pray the prayer below as a family:

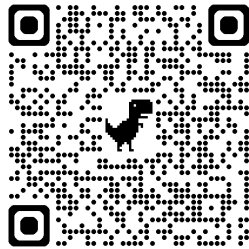

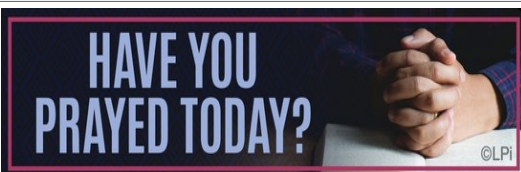

Backpacks are our children's constant companions as they go about their school days. As they start a new school year we would like to give them a blessing to remind them that God is with them in their daily life and that their church family will be praying for them throughout the year!

Discernment & the Holy Spirit: What Direction Are You Headed In?



If you have been following along with this column over the last month, you will know that we are exploring the insights of St. Ignatius of Loyola about “discernment of spirits.” How are we to know if our thoughts, feelings, and interior experiences are being influenced by the Holy Spirit – or by another spirit or influence seeking to lead us astray? And then, when we are aware of what is happening within us and understand the source, how are we to take action and respond?

In an earlier column, we considered the **examen prayer**, offered by Ignatius as a helpful way to **become aware** of our interior moods and movements. Now, we turn our attention to the next step: **understanding the influences** behind those interior movements in our souls. We’ll follow this thread for several columns, so I hope you come along for the ride. Previous columns are available online at the St. Raphael website, if you find it helpful to read what you might have missed.

The first important step in seeking to understand the source of spiritual influences on our souls is to **know the fundamental direction our lives are headed in** (Gallagher, *The Discernment of Spirits*, p. 31 and following).

- Are we steadily seeking to grow closer in our relationship with God? Are we serious about avoiding sin and seeking to do the good?
- Or are we headed in the opposite direction, away from God and towards what is wrong?

Knowing our fundamental direction – either toward God or away from him – is very important, because the Holy Spirit and the unholy spirits seeking to influence us act differently depending on this direction. How do they act differently? That will be our topic for next week!

Our “homework” for this week is to honestly consider what direction we are headed in – and if it’s away from God, let’s turn back to him. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is the best place to turn around!

Summer Catholicism 101: Encountering Jesus in the Gospel of John

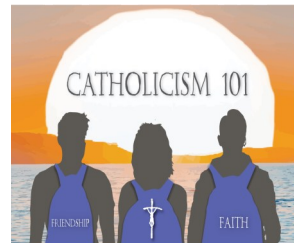

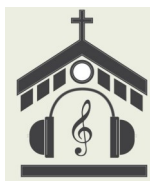

The Importance of Giving Thanks

The importance of gratitude strengthens our relationships, deepens our faith and prepares us for our eternal destiny. One of the most important lessons parents can teach their children is gratitude. Learning to say thanks for kindness big and small, such as by sending a thank you to grandparents for a birthday gift, saying a prayer of thanksgiving before meals, or expressing thanks to a brother or sister for help with homework.

Gratitude is like oil in the gears of human relationships. It helps things run smoothly. A genuine word of thanks brings joy, but our gratitude has to be sincere. Otherwise, it does more harm than good. Real gratitude comes from the heart.

Gratitude can surprise us. Sometimes, out of the blue, a stranger will treat us with kindness, no strings attached. It might be something simple, like helping us lift luggage into an overhead bin. Or something dramatic, like saving us from danger. Gratitude can suddenly well up in our hearts for those who die in the line of duty, even if we have never met them. We can be astonished when someone we don't get along with reaches out, seeking to mend fences. Whenever enmity is laid to rest, we should feel especially grateful.

When we are grateful for the gift of life, we will strive to protect it. When we are grateful for our faith, we will try to deepen it and spread it. When we are grateful for God's blessings, we will share them with others.

Let us indeed give thanks to the Lord our God, for it is right and just!

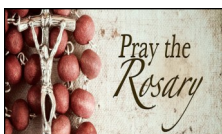
