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Dear Parishioners,

On August 15 each year, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In my life as a Protestant, I had no idea that this holy day even existed – and if you had told me what it was about, I would have chalked it up to another weird thing about the Catholic faith and filed it away under “crazy Catholic ideas about Mary.”

I still think it is kind of a crazy thing, in the best possible way. As Catholics, we believe that a flesh-and-blood human being, the Blessed Virgin Mary, was assumed (taken up) into heaven to dwell there forever. It's not just Mary's soul that is in heaven, but her whole self, body and soul. Not only this, but we believe that someday this could also be true for all of us, if we remain faithful to the Lord. As we profess in the Apostle's Creed, we believe in “the resurrection of the body.” After Jesus returns at the end of time, it's not just our souls that will be in the new heaven and earth; our bodies, resurrected and in a new and glorified state, will be there as well. Can you imagine what that will be like?!

As I got to know Mary on my journey into the Catholic faith, I came to have a deep gratitude for her. In so many ways, she leads us to her son Jesus and shows us what it looks like to follow him faithfully. At the very end of her earthly life, Jesus once again brings hope to us through his mother. He draws her to his side in heaven to show us what he desires to do for us all someday. Once again, Mary leads the way to Jesus, and we follow.

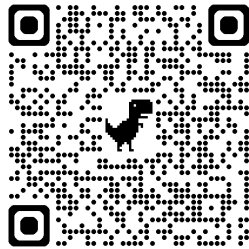

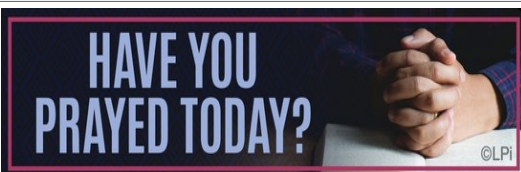

A Place Where Children Grow in Faith

Jesus said, Let the little children come to me; do not prevent them, for the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these." ~Mark 10:14

One of the greatest gifts we can give our children is a strong foundation in the Catholic faith. Our parish is blessed to offer many opportunities for children of all ages to grow in their relationship with Jesus, learn about their faith, and become active members of our parish family.

Our Religious Education program helps children discover the beauty of Scripture, prayer, the sacraments, and Catholic traditions. Through caring for catechists and engaging lessons, children learn not only about their faith but how to live it every day. We offer Sunday School every other Sunday during the 10am Mass from September-April for children in 4K and Kindergarten.

Children are also invited to participate in the celebration of the Mass. Whether they serve as altar servers, sing in the children's choir, bring up the gifts during the offertory, or simply worship alongside their families, they are an important part of our parish community. Their presence reminds us that the Church is alive and growing. On Sunday during the 10am Mass we offer Children's Liturgy of the Word, children age 4K-2nd grade are called forward and process back to the chapel where they will listen to the Gospel presented at their level and do an activity that relates to the Gospel reading.

Throughout the year, our parish offers special opportunities such as Vacation bible School, family events, Camp Tekakwitha, seasonal celebrations and preparation for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. These experiences help children build friendships rooted in faith while learning the joy of serving God and others. Watch the bulletin or the parish website for these events.

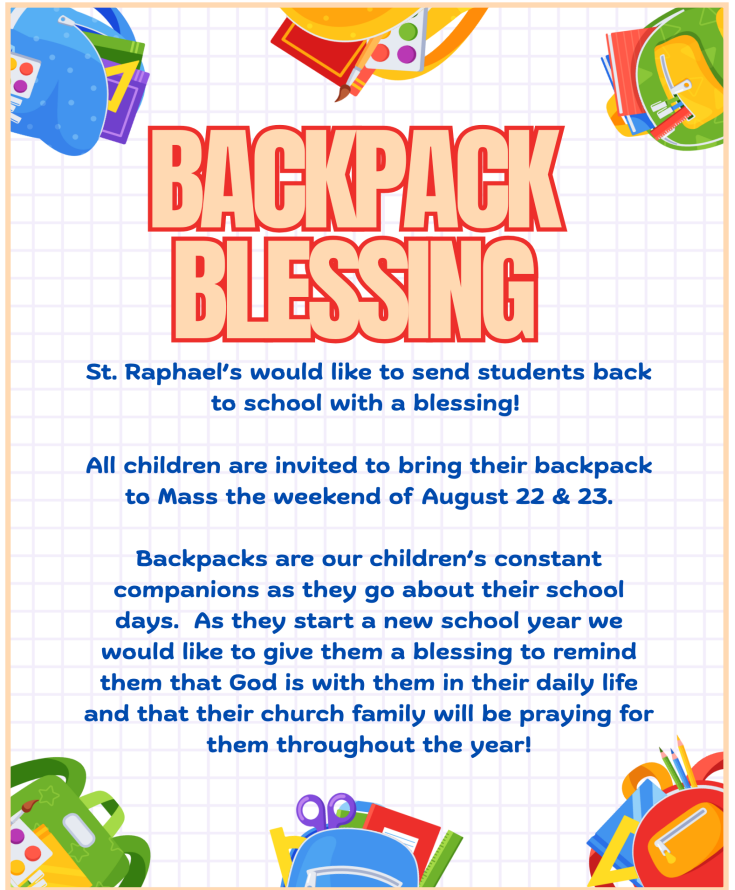

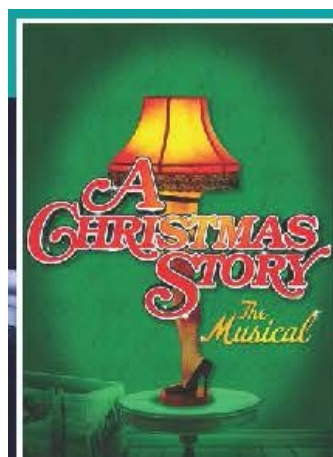

Discernment & the Holy Spirit: What Happens When We're Headed in the Wrong Direction



As we seek to understand the spiritual sources that influence our thoughts, feelings, and interior movements – what St. Ignatius would call the “discernment of spirits” – it is important first to know what direction our lives are headed in. Are we steadily seeking to grow closer to God? Are we serious about avoiding sin and seeking to do the good? Or are we headed in the opposite direction, away from God and towards what is wrong?

This is important to know because the spiritual influences in our lives, whether that is the Holy Spirit or an unholy one seeking to lead us astray, act differently depending on what direction we are going.

We'll start with what happens when we're headed in the wrong direction. When we are moving away from God, the Holy Spirit is like a pesky wasp or fly, to use Ignatius' metaphor, stinging and biting our conscience to help us see how what we are doing is hurting ourselves and others. On the contrary, the enemy of our souls uses every appealing method to persuade us to stay on the wrong track we're currently on.

An example might be helpful here. Let's imagine that John is a college student at UWO. It's his first semester on campus, and he has spent the first months enjoying the party scene, with all that involves. One Saturday night, he has the thought, “I know my parents would want me to go to Mass tomorrow. It's been so long since I went.” He feels some remorse about this and about the number of times he's had too much to drink lately. He feels the sting of conviction that the best thing to do would be to come home at a reasonable time and go to Mass the next day.

On the other hand, another voice tells John, “But you're going to miss out on the best party of the semester! And you are so much more fun to be around when you're drinking. Why would you give that up?” The thought of going to the party feels like the more fun thing to do and a good way to forget about how his grades haven't been the best this semester.

John's life is currently headed away from God. He hasn't been going to Mass, and he has been drinking to excess, to the point that his schoolwork is suffering. At this moment, the Holy Spirit is stinging his conscience, offering him an opportunity to make a better choice. Meanwhile, another much less helpful spirit is encouraging him to keep partying, offering thoughts of how great it will be.

Ignatius observes that this dynamic is true for anyone headed away from God. The Holy Spirit convicts, so that the person will decide to return to the right path; the evil spirit provides every encouragement to the person to stay on the wrong path.

Next week, we'll look at the reverse dynamic: what happens when someone is headed in the right direction toward God.

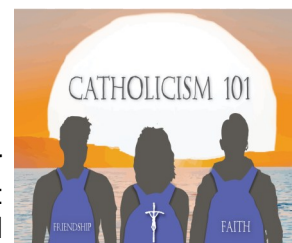
Summer Catholicism 101: Encountering Jesus in the Gospel of John

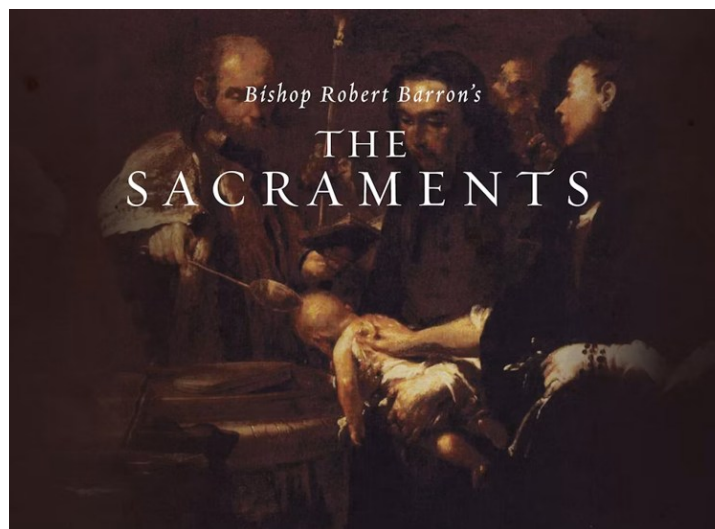

St. Therese of Lisieux called prayer "a surge of the heart" – the soul's response to the gentle pull towards communion with God. In this five-session course, we will explore the rich vision of Christian spirituality and the place of prayer within it, seeing prayer not merely as a practice but as a growing relationship with God. From this wider perspective, we will consider practical ways of praying and the challenges that often accompany the journey.

This course is for those who have ever felt confused or uncertain about prayer, and for those who want to deepen their own prayer life.

Sessions:

1. The context of prayer – where prayer happens
2. Temples of the Spirit – desire, longing, and sacred hearts
3. How we talk to God – methods of prayer
4. How God talks to us – listening for the still, small voice
5. Dealing with common obstacles in prayer
