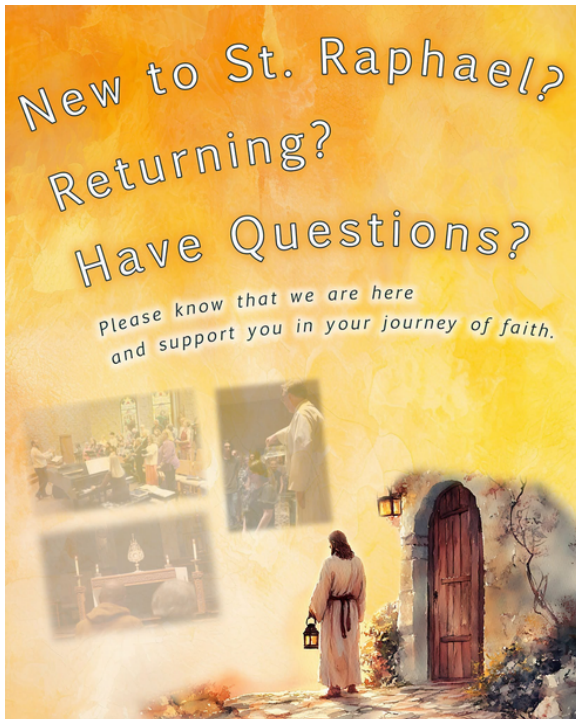

### LOURDES HAPPENINGS

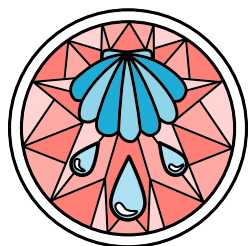

### Bringing Young Children to Mass: A Gift of Faith

Bringing young children to Mass can sometimes feel challenging. They may wiggle, whisper, cry, or have trouble sitting still. Parents may wonder if they are disturbing others. But our children belong in the Church, and there is no better place for them to learn that they are part of God's family than at Mass.

Children learn by watching us. When they see their parents, grandparents, and other adults praying, listening to God's Word, receiving the Eucharist, and participating in the Mass, they begin to understand that faith is an important part of life. We should not expect young children to behave like adults at Mass. Their little voices and movements are part of their journey of learning. Each Sunday they are practicing learning when to stand, sit, kneel, pray, and respond. Even when they don't understand everything, God is planting seeds of faith in their hearts.

Most importantly, don't let the fear of disturbing others keep you from bringing your children to Mass. Our parish community should be a place where families feel welcomed and supported. The sounds of children remind us that our Church has a future.

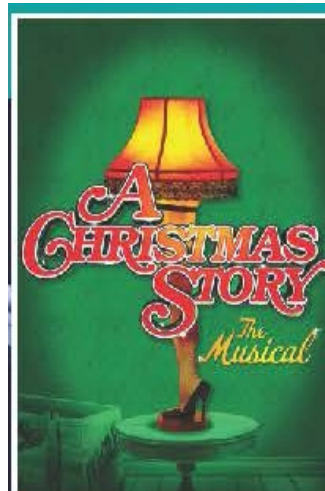

## Discernment & the Holy Spirit: In Desolation, Do a Little More

Last week, we discussed St. Ignatius's wise counsel not to make any changes to our plans for prayer during times of spiritual desolation (that is, those times when we feel a darkness or disturbance in our soul, are drawn to low and earthly things, or are disquieted and agitated, lukewarm, sad, or slothful when it comes to the things of God). This is one of his most important "rules" for handling times when an unholy spirit is seeking to influence us. If we give up on prayer, Ignatius would say that we are basically giving up on the Holy Spirit and choosing to follow an unholy spirit instead.



Ignatius's next "rule" provides an additional counterweight to our impulse to stop praying when things get hard. In addition to not giving up on the practices of prayer we had already committed to before we started experiencing spiritual desolation, Ignatius also tells us that it is "very advantageous" to act against desolation by doing more than we had planned. For example, if we had planned to pray for 15 minutes that morning, we pray for 20 minutes instead. If we intended to pray a full rosary, we might pray an extra decade. We go beyond whatever we had planned to do as an active way of resisting the temptation to quit praying, which can be very strong in times of desolation.

Along those same lines, Ignatius would also recommend that we add some penance into our lives during times of desolation. We often think of penance in terms of depriving ourselves of something (like giving up chocolate at Lent), and we could do something like this. However, we might find it more helpful to add in something good to replace the false sources of comfort we tend to turn to when we are in a low spot. So, instead of giving into the temptation to doomscroll on the phone, we could go for a walk. Instead of binge-watching the latest show, we could find some small way to serve a family member or friend.

To summarize, in times of spiritual desolation, we must never give up on any plans we have made to pray, and in fact, we will find it very helpful to actually do even just a little more than we had planned. Resisting the temptation to turn to false comforts when we are feeling low and choosing to do something good instead will also help get us back on track. Making these choices is the best way to resist the unholy spirits that seek to influence us by pulling us away from God.

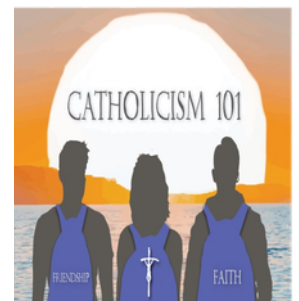

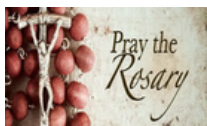
