



Mass Notes

As a part of the confirmation process, we would like to invite you to engage more prayerfully and intellectually in the weekend Mass experience. On top of attending Mass every weekend, and attending all the Holy Day Masses, we ask that you complete eight “Mass Notes” for either weekend liturgies or Holy Day Masses. **You are asked to complete one Mass Note for each month (September-April).** Mass Note sheets will be available in the gathering space as they enter the Church for Mass (at St. Raphael), and students should submit their Mass Notes to their Confirmation Teacher by the last class of each month.

Each of the eight Mass Notes must include these five things:

1. Date of Mass
2. Name of Parish and presiding priest
3. Briefly summarize the Gospel you heard.
4. In one or two sentences summarize the homily you heard.
5. How might the Gospel reading or homily apply to your life? And, how does the message challenge you to live differently this week?
6. Identify a word, phrase, or moment that stuck out to you from Mass—from the prayers, the readings, the homily, the songs, the community, the sights, sounds, or scents, etc. What might God be trying to reveal to you through further reflection on that moment?
