

Fourth Grade Supply List

- wooden pencils (bonus if they are already sharpened) - at least 20
- 2-4 large pink erasers
- 5" scissors *
- 2 large glue sticks
- 12" ruler *
- 4 count **black** expo markers
- 10 or 12 count washable markers
- 24 count colored pencils
- red ink pens (at least 5)
- 2 highlighters (color does not matter)
- 1 durable pencil pouch with three rings (to put in binder) *
- 1 durable pencil box (this will be for their markers, colored pencils, glue, etc)
- 2 black composition books (wide ruled)
- 2 durable pocket folders (color does not matter)
- 1" durable, vinyl three ring binder (color does not matter) *
- 1 pack of dividers with tabs *
- 1 clipboard *
- 1 pack of colored paper (not construction paper, just 8x11 colored paper. The colors can be all the same or come in a variety)
- 1 Package of Band-aids
- 1 bag of Lifesaver Mints
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- Facial covering
- Old beach towel (to sit on for outdoor class or lunch)
- \$5 to cover the cost of a vinyl scrapbook we will use for our KY State Project

*We will use the same binder system as we did in third grade, so feel free to reuse the three-ring binder, dividers, and pencil pouch. Students can also use their clipboard, scissors, rulers, and any other items from last year if still in good condition!
