- Overview: The teacher shall preferably be a college graduate with a degree in education, who feels called of God to the teaching profession. Other qualifications may be added as the board deems appropriate.
- Hired by: Principal or personnel committee of school board.
- Responsible to: Principal.
- Supervises: Student teachers, aids, volunteers, and students.
- Evaluation: Teacher performance will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of the School Board's policy on evaluation.

Required Personal Qualities

The teacher shall:

- Be a Christian role model in attitude, speech, and actions towards others. This includes being committed to God's Biblical standards for conduct (Luke 6:40).
- Be a member and regular attendee at a church that has a Statement of Faith in agreement with the School's Statement of Faith.
- Support and be in whole-hearted agreement with the School's Statement of Faith and Christian philosophy of education and code of conduct.
