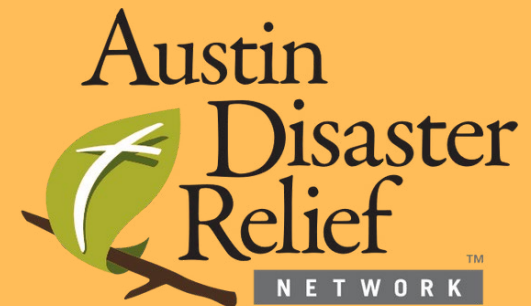

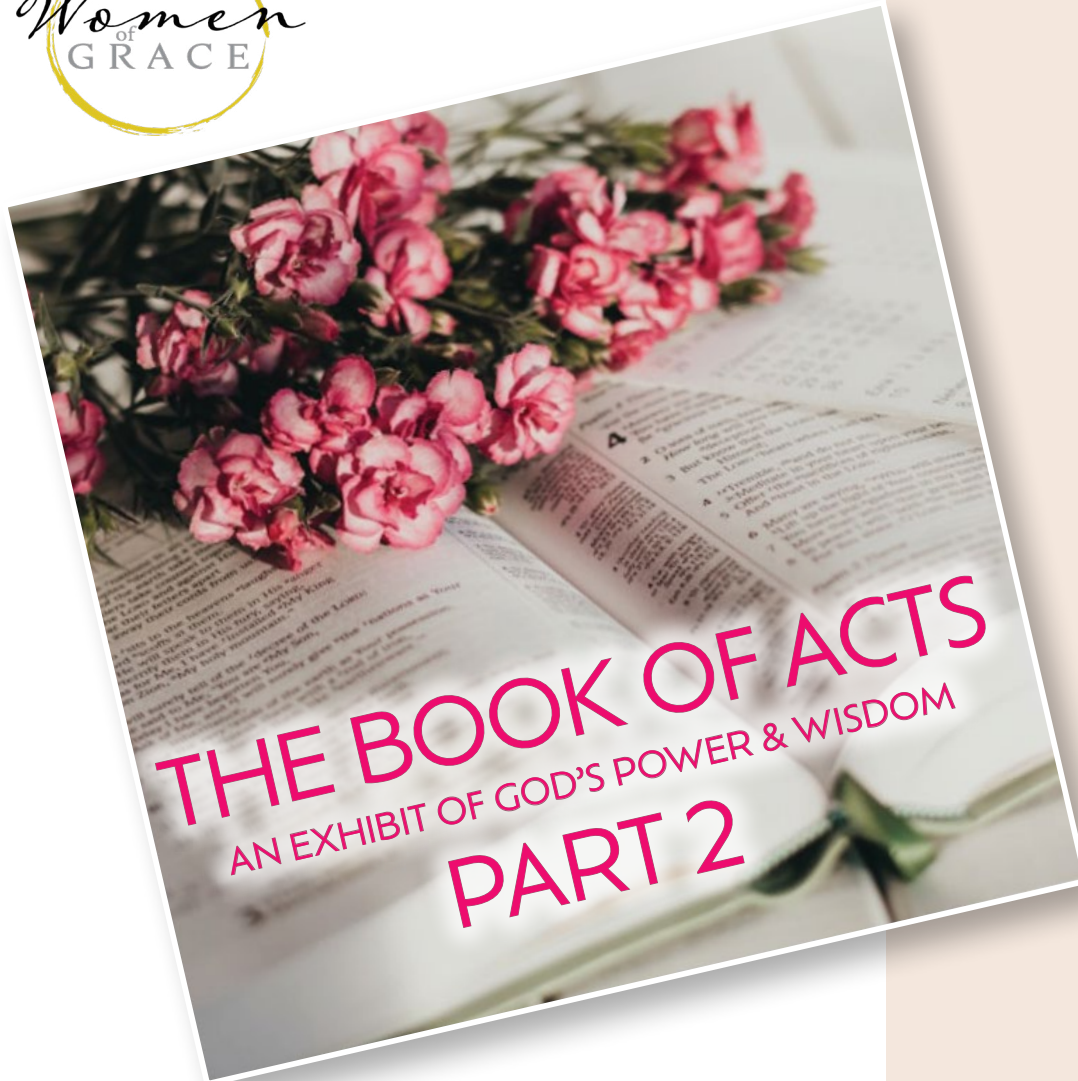
A group of youth will be leading the children of Branches in a series of Grace Games.
