

WHAT TO EXPECT

We will still be offering online worship service so even if we are meeting in our sanctuary, you are able to worship with us online at home.

1. If you have: Fever over 100, Cough or sore throat, Shortness of breath or have had contact with anyone confirmed to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days, we ask you please do not come to the service.
2. We ask you all to please maintain a six-foot distance from all non-household members at all times.
3. Smile with your eyes, wave and say hello, but please don't hug or touch others during this season.
4. In order to create a spacious, safe experience: Services will only be filled to a maximum of 25% capacity, which is about 125 people. Please allow three chairs or six feet to remain between you and any non-household member during the service. We will have areas in our sanctuary marked off to ensure space.
5. We encourage masks to be worn at all times by all worshippers. All volunteers and staff will wear masks. Masks are strongly encouraged but not required except for during congregational singing. If you would like to sing, you will be asked to wear a mask during that portion of the service.
6. We encourage those who are elderly and those with health concerns to continue to worship online only.
7. Children are required to stay with their parents at all times. At this time, no kids ministry can be provided. We will provide crayons and activity pages for the kids (and adults if you wish!).
8. We are asking that you not do a lot of fellowshiping in the foyer before the service or following the service to permit us to maintain proper social distance of 6 ft. Hopefully weather will permit it outside.

9. We will not be offering coffee/donuts for now.
10. Offering will be on mobile devices, at door or in foyer.
11. Service length will be simplified and shortened to keep to less than one hour.
12. When communion is offered, it will be pre-packaged handed to you.
13. The facility and chairs will be disinfected before each service.
14. Hand sanitizer stations will be provided.
15. If you show any symptoms of illness during a service, we will kindly ask you to remove yourself from the building and finish out the service online.
16. Services will be streamed LIVE from our church service to Facebook live every Sunday.
