This is to confirm that Matt Dietsche enrolled in the Distance Learning CPE Program - Extended Unit with the Lutheran Partners CPE. The Spring/Summer Extended CPE Unit started on March 4, 2024 and concludes on August 27, 2025.

Final evaluations are written at the conclusion of the unit, within 21 days of the last day of the CPE Unit. ACPE standards do not call for midterm evaluation.
