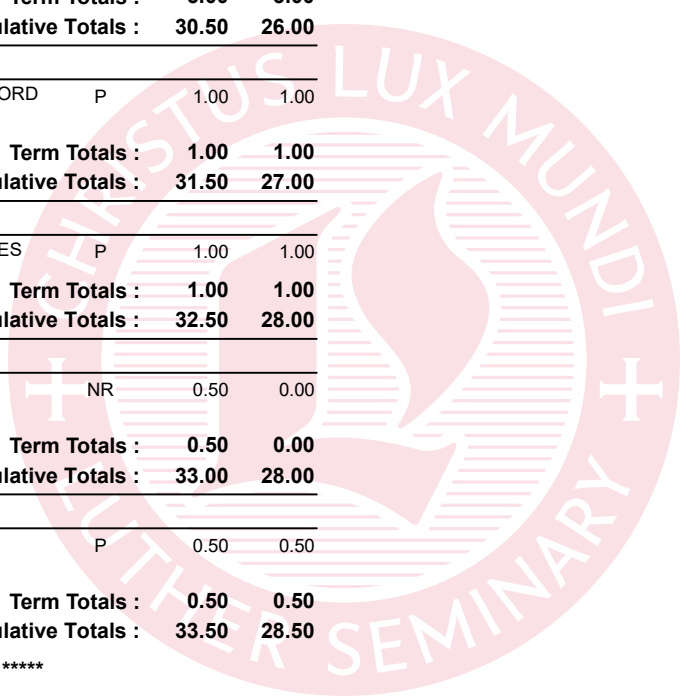

Calendar System

Luther Seminary is currently on a semester system since the 1998-99 academic year. Prior to 1998-99 operated on the quarter system. The unit of credit is one semester course which, in most courses, represents one 50-minute class period plus the required preparation. One full course (1.0) is equivalent to 3.00 semester hours. A half course (.50) is equivalent to 1.50 semester hours.

Explanation of Current Curriculum Course Numbers

Each course number consists of a two letter prefix and a four-digit course number. The two-letter prefix identifies the curricula area in which the course is offered.

The four-digit course number refers to the following classifications:

The first digit identifies the curricula level (Signature, Core, or Elective).

The second digit identifies the curricula division (OT, NT, HC, etc.).

The third and fourth digits identify general numbers.

Grading System

Letter grades are required for Th.M./D.Min./Ph.D. programs, and may be requested by a student in other programs.
