- Demonstration of spiritual maturity and integrity.
- Ability to lead and deploy teams of people to accomplish events and tasks.
- Strong team player; good follow-through with people and tasks.
- A faithful follower of Jesus Christ, actively seeking a deeper relationship with Him.
- Models biblical disciple-making in their home and community.
- Faithfully stewards their time, talents, gifts, and tithe as unto the Lord.
- Exhibits a servant's and shepherd's heart for ministry to the body of Christ.
- Disciplined and diligent with their time, keeping a balance between home and work.
- Is present at official gatherings, meetings, and outreach events unless otherwise coordinated with supervisors.
- Maintains confidentiality with sensitive church information.

Ministry Responsibilities:

- Assist in the planning and execution of engaging and gospel centered Sunday and Wednesday Student and/or Kids Ministry gatherings.
- Help plan and execute weekday ministry activities such as (but not limited to), student hang outs, bible studies, and summer events.

- Provide radical hospitality at each event, striving to welcome every student and assist in the transition of our current 5th graders into middle school ministry.
- Meet, gather, and assimilate new youth into youth group summer activities.
- Attend and help facilitate Student Camp and Pre-teen Camp (if needed)
- Attend and help facilitate the Student Mission Trip.
- Assist the children's ministry with the set-up, mobilization of student volunteers, and execution of VBS.
- Build positive, professional and supportive relationships with families.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Children or Student Minister.
