

Creative Bible Journaling

Creative Bible Journaling is a an opportunity to engage with God's Word creatively. It's a devotional process which helps you meditate on and respond to scripture, and is also useful for memorization. It's a way to experience God Word in a new and creative way.

Creative Bible Journaling can be done simply with a good pen and blank sheets of paper, with colored pencils and pre-printed coloring sheets (many available free online), or you can try colored pencils, watercolors, paints, stickers, or washi tapes, etc and a specialized Bible like the Inspire Bible. The following Process is from "Introduction to Creative Journaling," by Amber Bolton:

Creative Journaling

Process

Pray

Ask the Holy Spirit to be present in your time with God's Word.

Read

Read a portion of Scripture. What passage did you choose?

Ask

What stand out in this passage?

What does this passage say about God?

How does this passage inform how I live?

Respond

Use the margin of the Inspire Psalms [or journaling page] to create an image as a response to what you learned through these four questions?

1. What phrase or picture do you want to put in the margin?
2. What colors come to mind with this phrase?
3. What pictures come to mind?
4. What techniques and supplies will you use on this page?
