

From the Desk of Pastor David

Entrusted with the Gospel

Jesus has entrusted the treasure of his ministry to us. He is trusting us to put the gospel to work in a risky world.

The A!bove and Beyond campaign and the series of presentations we've had over the past few weeks on "We Are Alleluia" have been helping us grasp this treasure we've been given and have called us to put that treasure to work.

There is another area of life where we have the experience of being entrusted with something precious and where we are asked to put our energy, love, and money to work. That's the work of raising a child.

Economists report that to raise a child from birth to age 18 costs on average over \$300,000 if you factor in food, clothes, housing, medical bills, etc. It's a lot of money. And parents do grumble about it from time to time. But I have never met any parent who said, "You know if I hadn't had that child, I would have another \$300,000 in my 401k plan." That ignores the priceless web of love and joy that is part of raising a child. It misses what a privilege it is to be entrusted with a life, and to have the chance to help a child grow.

And if our child needs braces, we usually find a way to pay for them, even if we have to scrape it together. And if the child wants music lessons, we usually find a way to make it happen. What would a parent rather spend their money on than helping their child thrive? It's not so much something you have to do; it's something you get to do. If you ever talk to a parent who has lost a child at an early age, you know that they would give anything to be able to be spend their money on music lessons or a prom dress, or a baseball glove.

Being entrusted with a living child demands a lot of us in energy, love, and money. Being entrusted with the gospel and being part of a living church demands something of us too in energy, love, and money. But it's not something we have to do; it's something we get to do.

A dying church won't ask us for much, and a dead church won't ask us for anything. But a living church, a church that puts the gospel to work, will ask us for our resources and our resourcefulness.

And what would we rather spend our money on than putting the life-giving gospel of Jesus Christ to work?

Nursery Care is Now Available During Worship Services


