Message from Pastor Joel

As you know, we've been focusing on gratitude lately at 103rd and Book. I wanted to take this opportunity to share some of the many things I am grateful for this month.



Gratitude for Improving Financials

About a year ago our treasurer, Roger Rusell, stood before the congregation and shared that based on current giving and anticipated expenses, Alleluia! Lutheran Church would run out of money in the third quarter of 2025. Three things happened that helped us through this crisis: 1) Thrivent, our mortgage company, graciously gave us 12 months of interest only payments on our mortgage. 2) Little Blessings Preschool was able to grow enrollment from last school year. 3) All of you stepped up and generously gave to support the mission of the church this past year. Through the work of the Stewardship Team and your generosity, we saw a 22% increase in pledging from 2024 to 2025. Gratitude for Our Ministries

Last month we kicked off our fall programs on Rally Day! We celebrated our community – beginning in worship, followed up with good food, playing on inflatables, and gathering school supplies for the Kids in Need Foundation. Later this month we will welcome Wheatland Salem Church to lease the CLC wing of our building as their new church home for the next two years—a place where they can gather for worship, fellowship, Bible study, and launch new ministries in our neighborhood. 
