Series: Overflow!

Title: Worshiping God. Worshiping with others.

Scripture: Psalm 65:8-13

Connecting

Take a moment to introduce yourselves to one another.
Share a “High” and/or “Low” from the past week with the group.

Opening Prayer

Read Today’s Scripture: Psalm 65:8-13

Discussion

1. Share a story of experiencing an overflow. (Anything from flooding, to crowds of people, to other things—good or bad—spilling over)
2. Have you experienced someone’s life of faith and it’s outcomes (joy, peace, assurance...) overflowing into your life? How did it impact you?
3. Pastor Mark talked about two kinds of modalities that exist: the “Myth of Scarcity” (The world is lacking) and the “Liturgy of Generosity” (The world is filled with possibility). What can be the outcomes of each way of approaching life? Which way do you tend toward?
4. Read Psalm 65 again with these two modalities in mind. What words does the Psalmist use to praise God and talk about what God has done? Which modality does this best represent?
5. Pastor Mark gave some ideas to foster a “Liturgy of Generosity” in our lives (Show gratitude, see opportunity, stifle negativity, give freely, worship regularly). What would you add to this list ?
