### **Discussion**

1. Please share an innocent and/or funny mistake you have made in your life with the group.
2. There are innocent mistakes we make that are harmless, but sometimes the mistakes we make have consequences. At your own comfort level, share a mistake you have made in your life that impacted others and/or yourself.
3. Read Romans 3:23. What do you think this verse is saying?
4. How do you feel when the Bible tells you that we all sin and we all fall short of God’s standard and glory? What do you think we should do knowing this Biblical truth?
5. King David wrote Psalm 23—and David made a lot of mistakes! What verse(s) in Psalm 23 do you think show God’s mercy and grace to someone who has sinned? Why? What verses speak specifically to you and why?
6. Pastor Tim encouraged us to, “Hold up the towel, not the trophy,” to remind us that Jesus modeled God’s heart as a servant when he washed his disciples’ feet. Can you share a time you metaphorically “picked up the towel” and served others? What was that experience like for you?
7. This sermon ended with an invitation to turn to the cross of Jesus for the forgiveness of our sins. Read 2 Corinthians 12:9. If God’s grace is sufficient to cover our sins, and His power is made perfect in our weaknesses (sins/mistakes), what does this mean for you?
