Connecting

Opening Prayer

Read Today's Scripture: Luke 10:25-37

Discussion

1. Jesus interacted with people outside of the Jewish faith all of the time. He was criticized for this. Why is it important to emulate Jesus in our daily lives and be willing to interact with people who aren't Christians and treat them the way Jesus would?
2. Do you have a close friend who isn't a Christian? What are the positive things about this friendship? What can you learn from one another? Do you believe God is calling you to witness to them about your faith in Jesus? Why or why not?
3. Pastor Tim said, "Christians are to be one at all times." In other words, we are always Christians, not just in Christian circles. How hard is this to do 24/7? How hard is it to be a Christian at your place of business? When you hang out socially?
4. In the sermon, it was said that we don't get to put limits on who we share the love of God with. Jesus died on the cross for ALL people. We don't get to choose who we share God's love with—Jesus calls us to love all people. What are ways Christians struggle to do this in matters of race? Politics? Religion?
5. What are practical ways we can share God's love with all people, and not just our family and friends?
6. Pastor Tim ended this series by saying, "Nothing should influence your relationships more than your Christian faith." What do you think about this statement? How do you feel when you hear this statement?
