The NorthRidge summer internship is meant to be a mutually-beneficial experience for the church and Intern.

The summer Intern will be a benefit to NorthRidge Church and the local community, providing important services that help NorthRidge carry out their vision of being *called into community to affect our community*.

The summer Intern will be responsible for planning, organizing and leading a variety of programs and events throughout the summer. There will be times requiring the Intern to be self-motivated and independent. Other times, the Intern will be working with a team under the leadership of a NorthRidge staff member. In all cases, the Intern will be working alongside a mentor.

The internship will be a benefit to the Intern as well. The Intern will gain valuable work-experience, and have the opportunity to develop a broad variety of skills. At the end of the internship, a successful Intern will have access to a positive character reference to be used in future endeavors. Perhaps best of all, the Intern will have the opportunity to feel a sense of accomplishment and having partnered in a significant ministry.

Quick facts:

- **Rate of pay: \$13.85/hour** (NOTE: if NorthRidge is the recipient of the Canada Summer Jobs Grant, there is the possibility of additional pay commensurate with the applicant's age and experience.)
- **Time of Internship: May 10 – September 10** (NOTE: if the successful applicant is a student in highschool for any of this time, adjusted dates may be discussed.)
- **Expected hours/week: 40**
- **Holidays: An Intern who is able to work between May 10-September 10 is entitled to 1 week off during the program.** (NOTE: restrictions may occur and so dates for holidays should be agreed on between the Intern and employer at the beginning of the program.)
- **Summer Camps: paid Inters(s) must be available to serve at our Foursquare Kids and Youth Camps from August 19-30.**
