Ministry of The Holy Spirit Israel: All Israel Shall Be Saved Romans 11:25-36

Last time...as the firstfruits (Abraham and Jesus) are holy, so is the lump (national Israel)
As the Root (Abraham and Jesus) is holy, so are the branches (national Israel)

Since God, for whom nothing is impossible, is able to graft the wild olive branches (Gentile believers) into the natural olive tree (Israel), He is certainly able to graft the natural branches (Jewish believers) into the olive tree again

So, wild branches, boast not against the natural branches!

Beware of your heresy, all those who believe God is finished with Israel and has no plans or promises for the nation moving forward!!

This time...this critical teaching/doctrine regarding national Israel concludes

v25-26a This Biblical mystery that is Israel...a mystery surrounding God's Plan of Redemption of fallen man-kind:

Blindness **in part** is happened to Israel **until** the fulness of the Gentiles come in Israel has NOT been disqualified or "knocked out of the game" but $\sqrt{1-2a}$, 11

When the number of Gentiles is reached...all Israel shall be saved

- 1. What do the believers of Replacement Theology do with this statement by God?!
- 2. What does this statement/mystery mean, being interpreted by Scripture?

Rom 2:28-29

The sign of the covenant with Abraham (Gen 15:6) is about

- faith, not works
- spirit, not the flesh

Hab 2:4

Then and now and always

Rom 9:6b-8

As Abraham's and Isaac's families were divided between **children of the flesh** (unbelievers) and **children of God** (believers),
so is Jacob's family

Israel = the children of God Disbelieving Jews are NOT "Israel" but = children of the flesh

A separation on a national scale is yet future, an unfulfilled prophesy

The "national" separation will take place during the 70th Week of Daniel/DoL

Dan 9:24

Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to 1) finish the transgression, and to 2) make an end of sins, and to 3) make reconciliation for iniquity, and to 4) bring in everlasting righteousness, and to (5) seal up (end, complete) the vision and prophecy, and to 6) anoint the most Holy.

Not all Israel is Israel...so

Ps 89:18, 30-37
Ezk 20:33-44
Zech 13:8-9

There is a King of Israel, so there is an Israel Ps 89:32

To separate the rebels/unbelievers...the tares (2/3) from the wheat (1/3) To "establish" Jewish choices...John 8:23-24

Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world. I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am *he*, ye shall die in your sins.

To fulfill/complete Dan 9:24

v26b-27 As it is written...as what is written?

The very words of God, NOT just some stories written by man

2 Peter 1:20-21

Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake *as they were* moved by the Holy Ghost.

Is 59:20-21a And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression (unbelief) in Jacob, saith the LORD. As for me, this *is* my covenant with them, saith the LORD;

There shall...a promise of God about the future

come out of Zion...Jerusalem

the...singular and exclusive

Deliverer...Savior, Messiah, Redeemer, the LORD God of Israel Himself Scripture interpreting Scripture

Ps 18:2 The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer;

my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and

the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.

Ps 40:17 I am poor and needy; yet the Lord thinketh upon me: thou

art my help and my deliverer

Ps 144:2 (the LORD) My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower,

and my deliverer; my shield, and he in whom I trust

and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob...a promise of God to remove the wickedness of Israel, national Israel

For this is My covenant...The Almighty God's contract with Israel, NOT Israel's contract with their God; the contract depends on God's faithfulness and holiness, NOT Israel's

Deut 13:17 cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of his anger, and shew thee mercy, and have compassion upon thee, and multiply thee, as **he hath sworn** unto thy fathers

Is 14:24 The LORD of hosts hath **sworn**, saying, Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposed, *so* shall it stand

Ps 89:16 In **thy name** shall they rejoice all the day: and in **thy righteousness** shall they be exalted.

when the God of Israel removes their sins (unbelief and all its manifestations)

Is 59:1-2 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid *his* face from you, that he will not hear.

Je	r 31:31	-37
Je	r 33:19	-26

Is 59:20-21a And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression (unbelief) in Jacob, saith the LORD. As for me, this *is* my covenant with them, saith the LORD;

Is 59:21b My spirit that *is* upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed (the believing remnant that always is), saith the LORD, from henceforth and forever.

Accordingly, the blindness in part of Israel will also cease/be removed

Zech 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for *his* only *son*, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.

Zech 13:6 And *one* shall say unto him, What *are* these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, *Those* with which I was wounded *in* the house of my friends.

v26-27 is future

What about national Israel during the Church's ministry to preach the Gospel?

- v28 The Gospel went by the Spirit-filled Church to the Jew first and then the Gentile Disbelieving Israel was, particularly during the early Church (exclusively then predominantly Jewish),
 - enemies of the Cross

Phil 3:17-19

Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping (Rom 9:1-4a), Rom 10:1-4), that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ (as are the adherents of Replacement Theology; His blood declared to be insufficient to save Israel): Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.

- enemies/adversaries and persecutors of the Church
 - o "militant" unbelievers...

John 16:2 They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service.

"Sauls of Tarsus" persecuting "the Apostle Paul"

o perverters of the Gospel...

Judaizers following and contradicting (adding to the Gospel) the Apostle Paul at every stop

BUT...

touching the election...regarding the sovereign selection unto salvation by the All-knowing God of foreknowledge (Ch 11:1a, 2a, 5) they are beloved...the "agapao-ed" of God for the father's sake...because God had so **sworn** to Al&J, who believed His Word

v29 Because the gifts...spiritual endowments and calling...the called of Jesus Christ (Rom 1:6), called saints/holy (1 Cor 1:2) of God...the gifts and the calling originate with God are without repentance...are irrevocable

Per Scripture

Num 23:19 God *is* not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do *it*? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it (His Word) good?

1 Sam 15:29 And also the Strength of Israel will not lie nor repent: for he *is* not a man, that he should repent.

Heb 6:18a That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie...

God does not ever change

He does not ever learn something He did not already know and then change His mind He is not ever surprised by anything any person says or does or anything that happens He does not ever make mistakes

Man's unfaithfulness does not change His faithfulness

A very important word: irrevocable"

- impossible to be repealed or annulled or altered No "recall notice" will ever come
- Permanent and unchangeable
- "written in stone" by "the finger of God

Replacement Theology claims that Israel broke God's covenant with Abraham when it rejected Jesus Christ at His first coming.

As a result, the covenant was repealed by God and He forever rejected Israel as a nation...absolutely contradicting what God said here

Those who call themselves Christians but believe Replacement Theology

- do not believe what God has said (the Word of God, the Truth)
- are calling the God Who CANNOT lie...a liar

Woe!

Repent!

Might they be also tried/refined by fire (Zech 13:9) lest they repent of their unbelief?

v30-32 As the old saying goes, What is good for the goose is good for the gander

Just as ye (Gentiles) in times past did not believe God, but have now been given mercy (from God) thru their (national Israel's) unbelief,

1 Thes 1:9-10ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead. *even* Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.

So they (national Israel) have not believed that thru your mercy (as we received from God) they may also be given mercy (also receive from God, $\sqrt{11}$)

Because God has concluded them all (national Israel) in unbelief so that He might have mercy on all (Jews and Gentiles...given to those who believe)

Rom 1:16-17

Gal 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, *it is* evident: for, The just shall live by faith.

Rom 3:19-20

Yet Micah 7:18-20

Who *is* a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth *in* mercy. He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, *and* the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast **sworn** unto our fathers from the days of old.

There is no difference between Jew and Gentile in God's Plan of Redemption of man-kind into sin and death

Salvation is by grace thru faith, not by works, not by nationality, not by any metric of the flesh or the world

Eph 2:1-10

The salvation of God is established on His supernatural mercy and grace,

NOT His Divine justice

Yet His justice must be satisfied if He is to give mercy and grace

Hence, why the Father sent His Son...for whosoever would believe, Jew or Gentile

Matt 5:17

Rom 10:4

Rom 5:10

Col 1:21-22

And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in *your* mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled In the body of his (sinless) flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:

The salvation from eternal death of sinners is

- God's nature
- God's will
- God's work
- God's gift

Which leads a right-minded sinner to exclaim:

v33 The depth of

• God's wisdom (truth and right-mindedness and just actions)

James 3:17 the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, *and* easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

Is 55:8-9 For my thoughts *are* not your thoughts, neither *are* your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. (i.e. the Gospel)

- 1 Cor 1:21-24 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom: But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.
- God's knowledge
 - o the number of grains of sand on earth and of the stars in heaven...
 - the number of which just exploded by orders of magnitude to mankind via the James Webb Telescope
 - each of which He named and placed
 - how many hairs on the head of every person who has ever lived and will ever live
 - o the contents of every person's heart
 - o the secrets of men (Rom 2:16)
- God's decisions (righteous, all of them)
- God's ways...using everything to conform us into the image of His Son, including trials, tribulations, suffering, pain, disappointment, sorrow, joy, victories, peace, grace, mercy (Rom 8:28-29)

are

- unsearchable...incapable of being investigated/scrutinized, unfathomable
- past finding out...impossible to track, untraceable

We humans, created in the image of God, simply cannot

- keep up with God intellectually (or any other way, for that matter)
- get our heads around the enormity of Being that is our Creator
- comprehend with our finite reasoning the mind of the Infinite God
- know all that is to be known...in order to believe

Therefore:

- 1. Asking God "Why?" is illogical; we haven't the mental capacity to understand
- 2. Our relationship with our Maker CANNOT be based on knowledge, it MUST be based on faith

The Creator has given every person a measure of faith...and the free will to invest it in what or whomsoever they so choose

Q: Do you want a god (created in your image) you can get your head around... or a God (in whose image you are created) that blows your mind!

v34-35 Who has known the mind/intellect/thoughts of the (All-knowing, Infinite) Lord? Who has ever been on the same wavelength as our Creator

- the Great Barrier Reef
- eyes...of all His created kinds
- brains...of all His created kinds
- Plan of Redemption of fallen man-kind

From whom did the Lord ever ask advice? To whom is God a debtor?

Who knows the depth and breadth of what God is doing in your life, day-by-day?

Which puts before us a choice:

- 1. to follow Him by faith, not knowing where we are going, but trusting Him and entering into His rest...benefiting from what He can do
- 2. to not follow Him by faith but endlessly and hopelessly striving for knowledge...getting the best we can do
- v36 For of him...originating from Him and through Him...because of Him and to Him...unto Him

are all things...no exceptions from "all"

The Beginning/the End, the First/the Last, the Alpha/Omega of all things: Jesus All things in part or in whole: Jesus

All things in part or in whole: Jesu All the promises of God: Jesus

True riches: Jesus

Which we will proclaim unto Him in His Throne Room

Rev 4:11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Who knows the depth and breadth of what God is doing in your life, day-by-day? What, How, When, Where, Why...idk
But I do know Who – Jesus!

Blessed is the person whose strength is in the Lord (Ps 84:5) Blessed is the person that trusts the Lord (Ps 84:12)

Application/Exhortation

The Lord has impressed upon my heart and mind and spirit the blasphemous deception that is Replacement Theology...God is done with Israel and the Church is the new Israel... which is flatly refuted in Rom 9-11

Both the Word of God and Replacement Theology cannot be true...one must be a lie

If God's promises to AI&J (national Israel) are not good, neither are His promises to us If one promise of God fails, they are all subject to failure

If one promise of God is empty...words without substance...every promise of God is empty

If one promise is repealed/retracted, every promise would be called into question and would be subject to scrutiny by...the creature

If God's promises are not 100% true, He cannot be trusted Trust would be destroyed, relationship would be impossible

1 Cor 1:7b-9 would be a lie and not truth

waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall also confirm you unto the end, *that ye may be* blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God *is* faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

Titus 1:2 is also a lie

In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began

Rom 1-8 is not true

But God...is faithful and trustworthy!

- Ever-faithful
- Always faithful
- Never unfaithful

Ps 89:2 Mercy shall be built up for ever: thy faithfulness shalt thou establish in the very heavens.

He does just as He has said...even when we don't

The Word of God is true

John 17:17 Rom 3:3-4

Rom 9-11 was God-breathed to refute/rebuke Replacement Theology... before Replacement Theology ever entered the mind of man ("wisdom of man" made foolish by the wisdom of God)

Satan is the liar...Replacement Theology is from him

Therefore, the call to every person who has been deceived by the lie from the liar regarding God's future plan for national Israel:

- 1. The only rational explanation for you listening to this message is that God the Holy Spirit led you to it to hear it
- 2. Th Holy Spirit wants alarm bells to ring in your heart and mind!

You are an oxymoron – an anti-Semitic "Christian"
You hate those Whom God loves
Israel is the apple of His eye so you are poking God in His eye
You carry His name yet you call Him a liar and fight against Him and fight
alongside His enemies (happening right now in Israel: the purpose of
Iran/Palestinian Islamic Jihad is to "remove the Zionist entity from the
map")

Repent!

2 Tim 2:15...for you are ashamed before the God that does not change and cannot lie

For us who believe what God has said – rest in His faithfulness to keep His promises

Prov 30:5 Every word of God *is* pure: he *is* a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

2 Tim 2:23-26 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes. And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all *men*, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And *that* they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.
